Please see attached survey sketch exhibit and google earth map of the proposed crossing over Fort Bend Co. DD. The proposed pole is located on Fort Bend County property approximately 15' away from the toe of slope of the FBC LID 19 levee. The other crossing pole is located on CenterPoint fee owned property. The remainder of the line will be located within existing CenterPoint (Formerly HL&P) Easements. Please let me know if this pole location and crossing is acceptable or not and if so we will proceed with the application process submittal.

This line is part of a reliability upgrade project and will benefit the surrounding residential area to provide more reliable electrical service.
