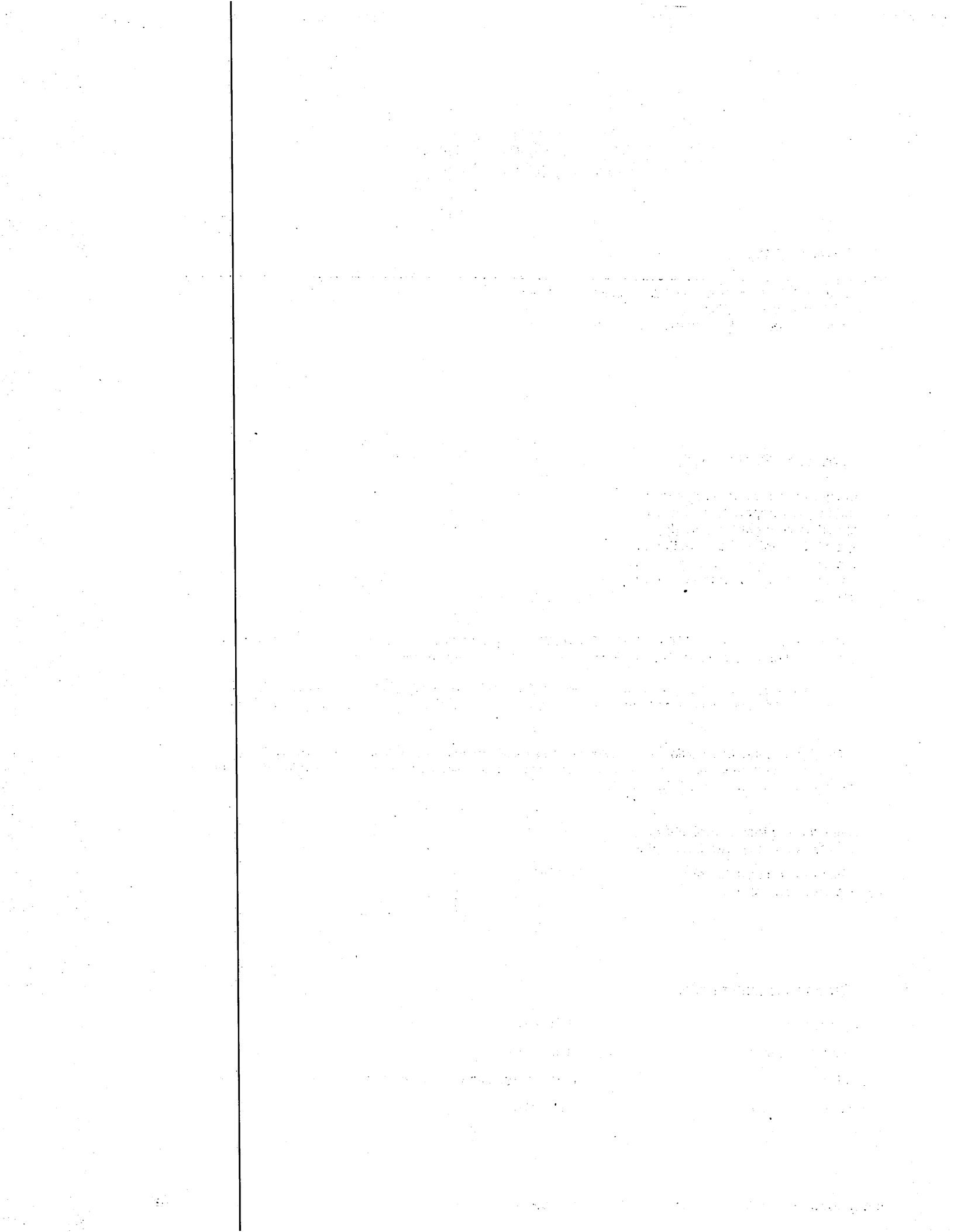

Currently, while we have a vet and vet tech on staff, we do not have any ability to provide x-ray services for the pets with those type of injuries. To be able to help those pets, we rely on social media and local 501c3 organizations who will raise funds to have the pets evaluated at a local contract vet.

The goal is to be able to provide for at least 65 of these pets that come in over the next 12 months.

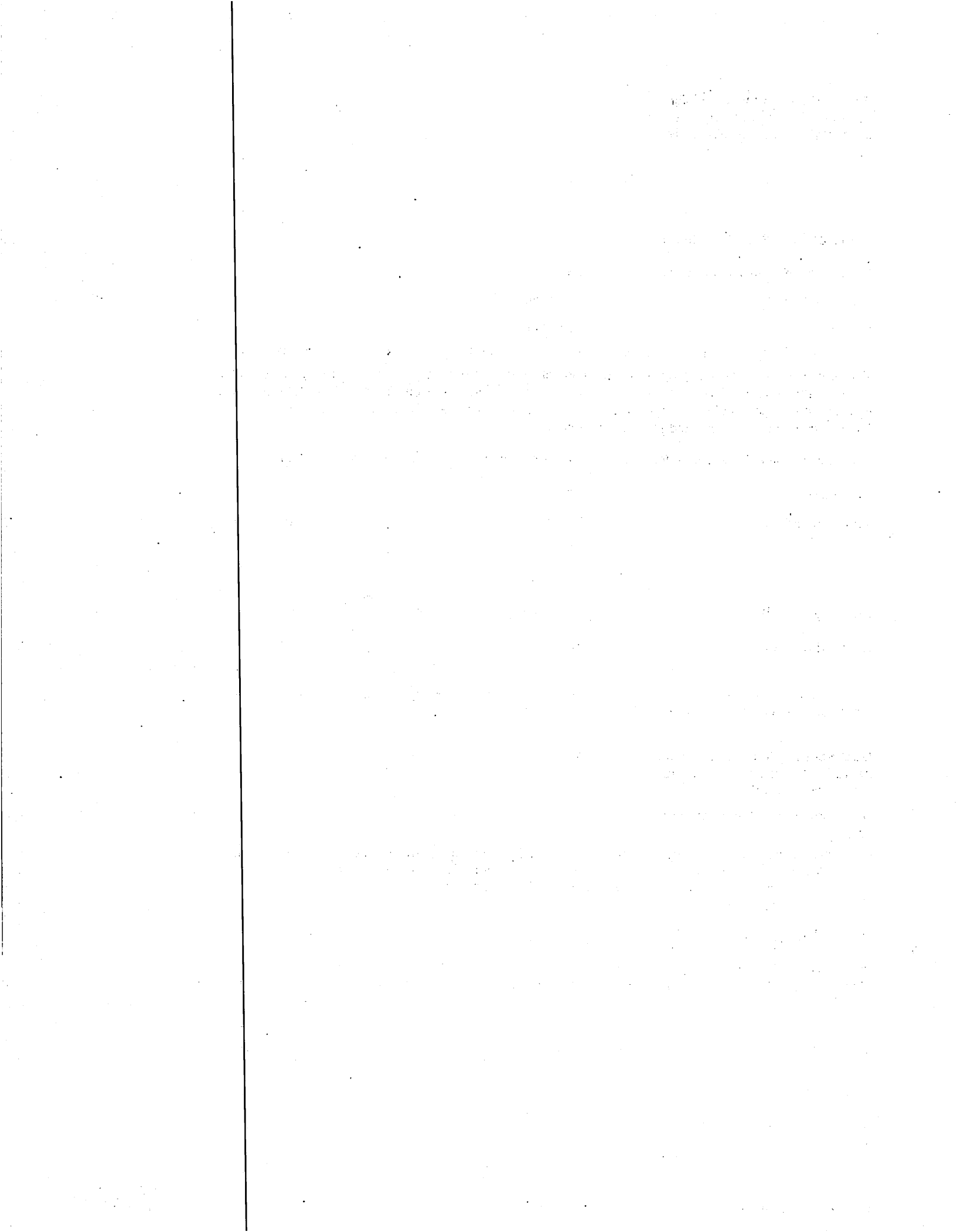

The goal is to be able to have a better understanding of the injuries and recovery period required by dogs and cats that come into the shelter with hit by car/injuries requiring radiographs so that we can network them for adoption, rescue or medical fostering.

At this time, we rely on 501c3 rescue organizations to fund radiographs at contract vet clinics for dogs or cats hit by a car.

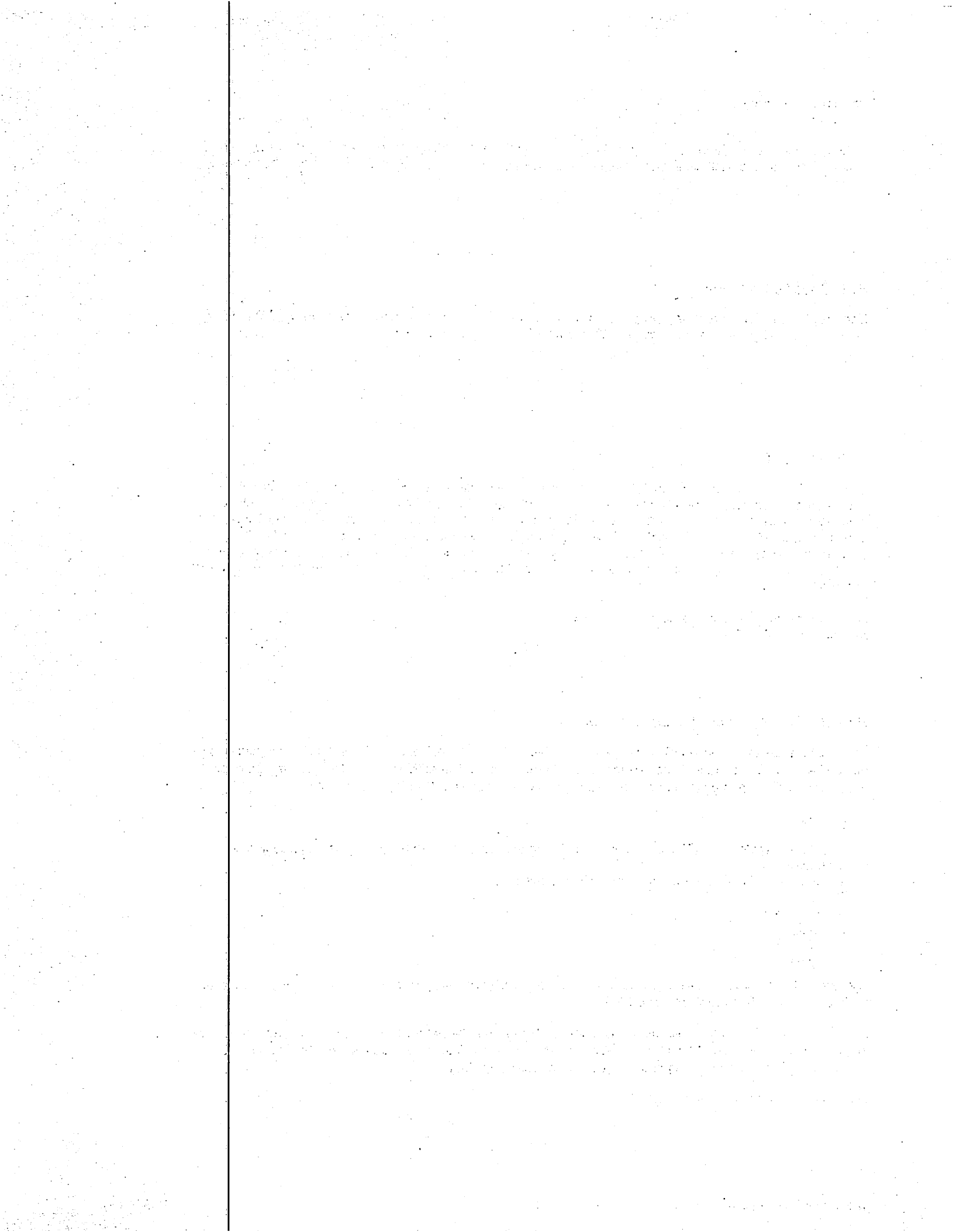
