Dear Judge Hebert,

This letter is to respectfully request changing the name of Williams Way Boulevard, north of 169/59, to Richmond Parkway.

We would like to implement the name change with a phased-in approach, beginning with the intersection of I69/59 coordinating with TxDOT and TxDOT's timeframe for installation of the overhead signs along with I69/59. Additionally, we will change the name in the Front/Fort Street area when the County begins construction on the widening project.

We would like to begin the process as soon as possible in order to market the change correctly. The City will coordinate with Fort Bend County Road and Bridge on installation of the road signs and work with the County staff on the logistics of our request. The City will be responsible for any additional cost, if any, of this request.

This will allow one of Richmond's Gateway entrances to be branded as a Richmond roadway and provide for our identity when entering our beautiful, charming City.

This amended request is consistent with the City Manager's comments during the November 6, 2018 Commissioners Court meeting.


