

**ORDER APPOINTING TONI WALLACE  
JUDGE OF FORT BEND COUNTY COURT AT LAW NO. 4**

On this day there came to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, ("Commissioners Court") the matter of an appointment to fill a vacancy in the office of Judge of Fort Bend County Court at Law No. 4.

**WHEREAS**, the resignation of the Honorable Jerry Bussell created a vacancy in the office Judge of County Court at Law No. 4; and

**WHEREAS**, Texas Government Code §25.0009 requires the Commissioners Court to fill a vacancy in the office of judge of a statutory county court; and

**WHEREAS**, Texas Government Code §25.0006 and §26.001 requires each judge of a statutory county court to execute a bond that is payable to the treasurer of the county in an amount not more than \$10,000 that must be approved by commissioners court; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge-Elect Toni Wallace meets the minimum standards to serve as a County Court at Law Judge under Texas Government Code Section 25.0014.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Fort Bend County Commissioners Court through a majority vote hereby appoints Judge-Elect Toni Wallace to serve as Judge of County Court at Law No. 4, effective December 7, 2018, upon subscribing to the official oath of office and delivery of a bond payable to Fort Bend County Treasurer, or his successors in office securing faithful performance of her duties to fulfill the vacancy of the office of Judge of County Court at Law No. 4 until she may qualify and assume the duties of the office for the regular term, in which she was elected, on, or as soon as possible after, January 1, 2019.
