**FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR  
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING INSPECTION SERVICES**

**THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT**, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and HJ Consulting, Inc., (hereinafter "Contractor"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Professional Engineering Inspection Services on February 23, 2016, (hereinafter "Agreement"), pursuant to SOQ 14-025, as amended by documents dated August 22, 2017, (hereinafter "Amendment"), December 12, 2017, (hereinafter "Second Amendment"), and February 6, 2018 (hereinafter "Third Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement for continuation of inspection services for the construction of Phase 2A of the Project, increase the total Maximum Compensation, and extend the Time of Performance under the Agreement to complete the services.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

1. County shall pay Contractor an additional one hundred fifty thousand dollars and no/100 (\$150,000.00) to continue all inspection services as described in the Request for Additional Funds dated November 19, 2018 attached as Exhibit "A" hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.
2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed one million fifty-five thousand dollars and no/100 (\$1,055,000.00), authorized as follows:
  - \$450,000.00 under the Agreement;
  - \$95,000.00 under the Amendment;
  - \$30,000.00 under the Second Amendment
  - \$330,000.00 under the Third Amendment; and
  - \$150,000.00 under this Fourth Amendment.
3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and any subsequent amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without further amendment executed by the parties.


4. The Time of Performance under the Agreement is hereby extended to end no later than May 31, 2019.
5. Certain State Law Requirements for Contracts
  - a. Agreement to Not Boycott Israel Chapter 2270 Texas Government Code: By signature below, Contractor verifies Contractor does not boycott Israel and will not boycott Israel during the term of this Agreement.
  - b. Texas Government Code Section 2251.152 Acknowledgment: By signature below, Contractor represents pursuant to Section 2252.152 of the Texas Government Code, that Contractor is not listed on the website of the Comptroller of the State of Texas concerning the listing of companies that are identified under Section 806.051, Section 807.051 or Section 2253.153.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement and the Amendment shall remain unchanged.

**Contract for Westpark Tollway Phase IIA for \$330,000 approved on 2/6/2018**

- Total upto date invoiced until 26 October \$268,812.50
- Average Weekly Billing is about \$7000
- Remaining Funds are about \$61,000 which will consume month of November and December 2018

**Request for additional Funds \$150,000**
