This Agency filed a full report

Precinct #1 Constable Fort Bend County has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1.) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2.) strictly prohibit peace officers employed by the Precinct #1 Constable Fort Bend County from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3.) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the Precinct #1 Constable Fort Bend County if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the Precinct #1 Constable Fort Bend County has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4.) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5.) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the Precinct #1 Constable Fort Bend County who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the Precinct #1 Constable Fort Bend County's policy adopted under this article;
- 6.) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - a.) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - b.) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and

c.) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and

7.) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision(6) to:

a.) the Commission on Law Enforcement; and

b.) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

  - (B) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and
  - (C) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and
- (7) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:
  - (A) the Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education; and
  - (B) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

### Comparative analysis for 2018

The Fort Bend Precinct One Constable Office patrols and delivers court related documents inside Precinct 1, Fort Bend County. This agency employs fourteen full-time deputies, two sergeants, one lieutenant, one chief deputy and the elected Constable.

Three of the deputies are assigned to fixed posts. No deputies are assigned full-time patrol duties, but during the course of serving court related documents, deputies are permitted to make traffic or investigatory self-initiated stops.

According to the U.S. Census website, on July 1, 2017, Fort Bend County Texas had an estimated population of 764,828. Of that population:

- 55.7% were White alone
- 21.1% were Black or African American alone
- 00.6% were American Indian and Alaska Native alone
- 20.4% were Asian alone
- 00.1% were Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander alone
- 02.2% were Two or More Races Present
- 24.5% were Hispanic or Latino
- 33.2% were White alone, not Hispanic or Latino
