Dear Commissioners:

We are requesting temporary road closure of Wildwood Park Road north of the roundabout within Veranda, Section 1 during construction, pursuant to Section 251.011 of the Texas Transportation Code. The request for temporary road closure dates are seven days between February 6, 2019 and March 1, 2019, pending weather.

This is to repair cracking which will require that the contractor shut down Wildwood Park Road for approximately 7 days in order to remove and replace it in accordance with the punchlist.

The request will be placed on the February 5, 2019 Commissioners Court agenda. The detour and traffic control plan is attached.

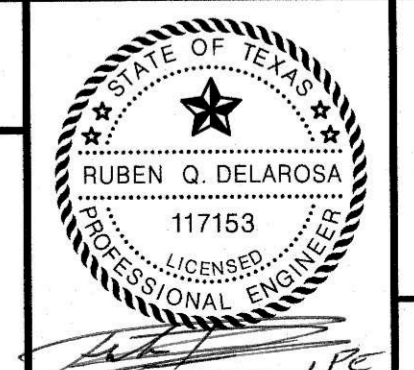
