Dear Rene,

As the official non-profit 501(c)(3) organization supporting Fort Bend County Services, Fort Bend PAWS (Pets Are Worth Saving) mission is to raise funds to provide for FBCAS those items and services not currently covered under the County budget. Therefore, on behalf of the Board of Directors of Fort Bend PAWS, I am pleased to enclose a check in the amount of \$15,000.00 (fifteen thousand dollars) to Fort Bend County Animal Services (FBCAS).

Once the funds are deposited in the appropriate account with the County and FBCAS has access to those funds, the Board respectfully requests that the funds be used for the following:

\$6000 towards costs for marketing and promotion of FBCAS and the pets housed at the shelter
\$3000 towards costs for out of state transport of pets from FBCAS to a receiving shelter
\$3000 towards costs of improving foster care program, purchasing crates for fosters and a medical fund to support the fosters that cannot be accommodated at the shelter for medical needs
\$2000 towards costs for dogs or cats requiring x-rays at a contract veterinarian on the recommendation of shelter vet
\$1000 towards costs for puppy and kitten bottle feeding foster supplies

All of us at Fort Bend PAWS are so proud of the good work and lifesaving efforts at FBCAS and look forward to a successful partnership between our organizations.
