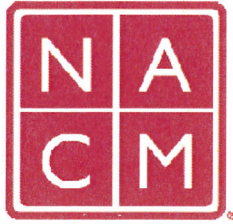

Court professionals share the responsibility of building strategic partnerships with the communities we serve and must meet the challenges presented by our changing society and the demands placed upon us by our citizenry.
