Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed the traffic control plan for the soon to be completed mobility project, Sansbury Boulevard between Grand Estates Drive and Williams Way Boulevard. The plan includes a two-way stop at the intersection of Sansbury Boulevard and Grand Estates Drive. Currently, the Sansbury Boulevard approach has a stop sign while the Grand Estates Drive approaches do not. When the extension of Sansbury Boulevard opens, in anticipation of Sansbury becoming the major road, the Grand Estates Drive approaches will stop while the Sansbury approaches will not. The public hearing date for acceptance for the plan will be scheduled on the next available Commissioner's Court Agenda.
