**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and Cobb, Fendley & Associates, Inc., (hereinafter “Contractor”), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Professional Engineering Services on May 22, 2018, (hereinafter “Agreement”); as amended by documents dated May 28, 2019, (hereinafter “Amendment”) pursuant to SOQ 14-025; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement for additional engineering services to be provided and increase the total Maximum Compensation for such additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

1. County shall pay Contractor an additional nineteen thousand four hundred one dollars and 57/100 (\$19,401.57) for the additional design and surveying services as described in Contractor’s request for amendment dated May 28, 2019 attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein for all purposes.
2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed three hundred fifty-five thousand one hundred eighty-seven dollars and 24/100 (\$355,187.24), authorized as follows:


\$321,403.00 under the Agreement; and
\$14,382.67 under the Amendment; and
\$19,401.57 under this Second Amendment.
3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and this Amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without further written agreement executed by the parties.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged.

Cobb, Fendley & Associates, Inc. (CobbFendley) is respectfully requesting an amendment to the Clodine Road widening contract, Mobility Bond Project #17417, for additional surveying and engineering design services at the direction of the Fort Bend County consultant management team. These services will be performed as soon as the notice to proceed is received from the Fort Bend County consultant management team in order to expedite the bidding process and keep the project on schedule.

Scope of Services

We will perform the following scope of services as supplemental basic services in addition to CobbFendley's current: "Agreement for Professional Engineering Services for "Clodine Road widening from Denver Miller to W. Belfort", Fort Bend County Mobility Bond Project #17417, executed in May 22, 2018 (Contract).

The scope of services performed is outlined below:

1. Provide surveying, ROW mapping services to prepare metes and bonds instruments and parcel sketches for 4 proposed variable sized corner cutbacks at the intersection of Clodine and W. Belfort.
2. Provide design efforts for the recommended drainage improvements for all quadrants of the W. Belfort at Clodine intersection not limited to extension of existing multi-barrel culvers, design of junction boxes, shallow manholes, area inlets and ditch grading.
3. Prepare additional plan sheets for the drainage design drawings, perform quantity take-off, and cost estimate to be incorporated into the Clodine Road widening improvements construction plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) package.

CobbFendley is requesting the total contract amount to be amended by \$19,401.57 on lump-sum basis for professional engineering design and surveying services. (See attached Exhibit "A" for the level of efforts).

This authorization will increase the overall compensations in this contract from \$335,785.67 to a total not to exceed amount of \$355,187.24.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Cobb Fendley will perform only such Additional Services, as are specifically agreed to in writing by Client and Cobb Fendley. Charges for additional services will be in accordance with the attached rate schedule. A copy of the *General Terms and Conditions of the Authorization for Professional Services* is attached and constitutes a part of this agreement.

SCHEDULE OF SERVICES

Cobb Fendley has completed the design work to date however; any/all comments related to the design and constructability of the work will be performed as part of the deliverables as soon we receive comments from the Fort Bend County Engineering and the managing consultant team.
