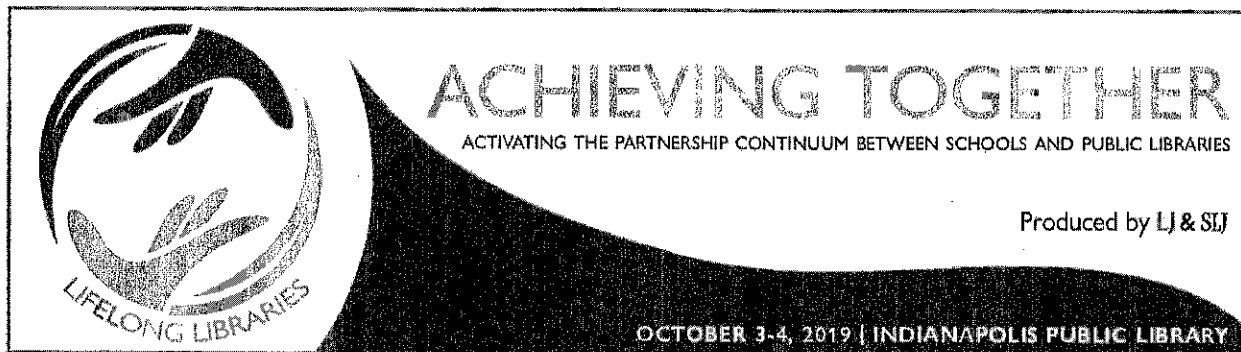


# Achieving Together: Activating the Partnership Continuum Between Schools and Public Libraries
