Dear Commissioner Meyers:

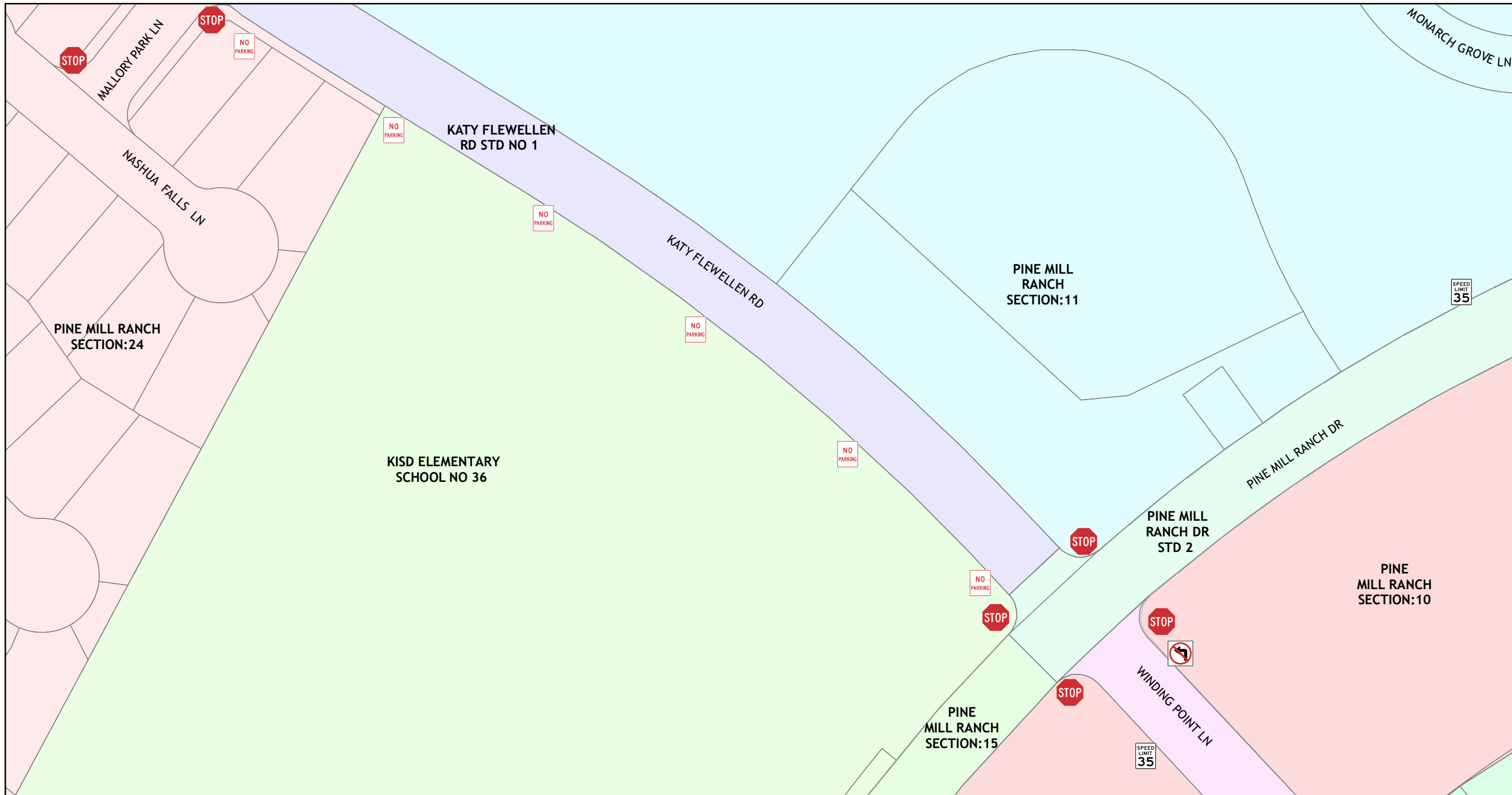
As requested by Katy ISD, Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed the traffic control plan to prohibit parking, stopping, and standing on the west side of Winding Point Drive between Pine Mill Ranch Drive and Mallory Park Lane. Additionally, northbound left turns from Winding Point Drive onto Pine Mill Ranch Drive will be prohibited. These prohibitions will both be in effect on school days, from 7:50 – 8:50 a.m. and 3:10 – 4:10 p.m. The public hearing date for acceptance for the plan will be scheduled on the next available Commissioner's Court Agenda.
