RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CONSTABLES RIFLE-RESISTANT BODY ARMOR  
GRANT APPLICATION #39897-01

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County desires to protect its law enforcement officers during the performance of their various duties; and

WHEREAS the County wishes to continue to support the protection of law enforcement officers by using body armor that can withstand high-velocity assaultive weapons; and

WHEREAS, the County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the Fort Bend County area, that the CONSTABLES RIFLE-RESISTANT BODY ARMOR GRANT be operated for the 2020-2021 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County agrees to provide all applicable support for the grant application submitted to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division on February 27, 2020, and attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division funds. Fort Bend County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division in full; and WHEREAS, Fort Bend County designates the Honorable Judge KP George, County Judge of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court, as the County's authorized official giving him the power to electronically apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Fort Bend County approves submission of the grant application for the Constables Rifle-Resistant Body Armor Grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division requesting \$106,565 in grant funds and no local match.
