FIFTH AMENDMENT TO PROJECT MANAGEMENT

THIS FIFTH AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and, Schaumburg & Polk, Inc., (hereinafter “Contractor”), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Project Management Agreement on September 2, 2014, (hereinafter “Agreement”) pursuant to SOQ 14-025, as amended by documents dated November 14, 2017 (hereinafter “Amendment”), August 28, 2018 (hereinafter “Second Amendment”), September 24, 2019 (hereinafter “Third Amendment”), and June 23, 2020 (hereinafter “Fourth Amendment”) for certain management and administrative support services for the 2013 Mobility Bond Project; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement to extend the Term of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree to extend the Term of Agreement to terminate on December 31, 2022, unless terminated or further extended as provided under the Agreement, or any subsequent amendment thereof.

BY ACCEPTANCE OF AGREEMENT, CONTRACTOR ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.

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Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement and subsequent amendments shall remain unchanged.
