Honorable Judge George:

Fort Bend County Engineering Department has received and reviewed a request (letter attached) from Odyssey Engineering Group, for Fort Bend County to sponsor a project for a public road widening of the 9th Street tie-in and right turn lane addition at Damon Street at Hwy 90A on behalf of Mandola Farms. The roadway connection improvements will improve traffic flow to Mandola Farms.
