RE: Benton Road at Irby Cobb Boulevard in Walnut Creek – All-Way Stop Control

Dear Commissioner:

The Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed a review of the operational conditions at the intersection of Benton Road at Irby Cobb Boulevard in response to a request for all-way stop control. The intersection currently operates with stop control on Irby Cobb Boulevard. Benton Road has a posted speed of 45 mph and is identified as a Major Thoroughfare in the 2015 Fort Bend County Major Thoroughfare Plan.

For westbound traffic on Irby Cobb Boulevard, a bridge rail creates an immovable restriction of sight distance to the south on Benton Road. As westbound traffic cannot safely traverse the intersection, an all-way stop is warranted and Engineering recommends the conversion of the intersection to all-way stop control.


