**RE: Avenue E between Dulles Avenue and FM 1092 – Speed Limit**

Dear Commissioner:

The Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed a review of the operational conditions along Avenue E between Dulles Avenue and FM 1092. The roadway currently has a posted speed of 45 mph and is identified as a Major Thoroughfare in the 2015 Fort Bend County Major Thoroughfare Plan.

Based on traffic counts and speed data collected, and the crash history along the corridor, Federal Highway Administration criteria recommend a speed limit of 40 mph. The updated traffic control plan is attached.

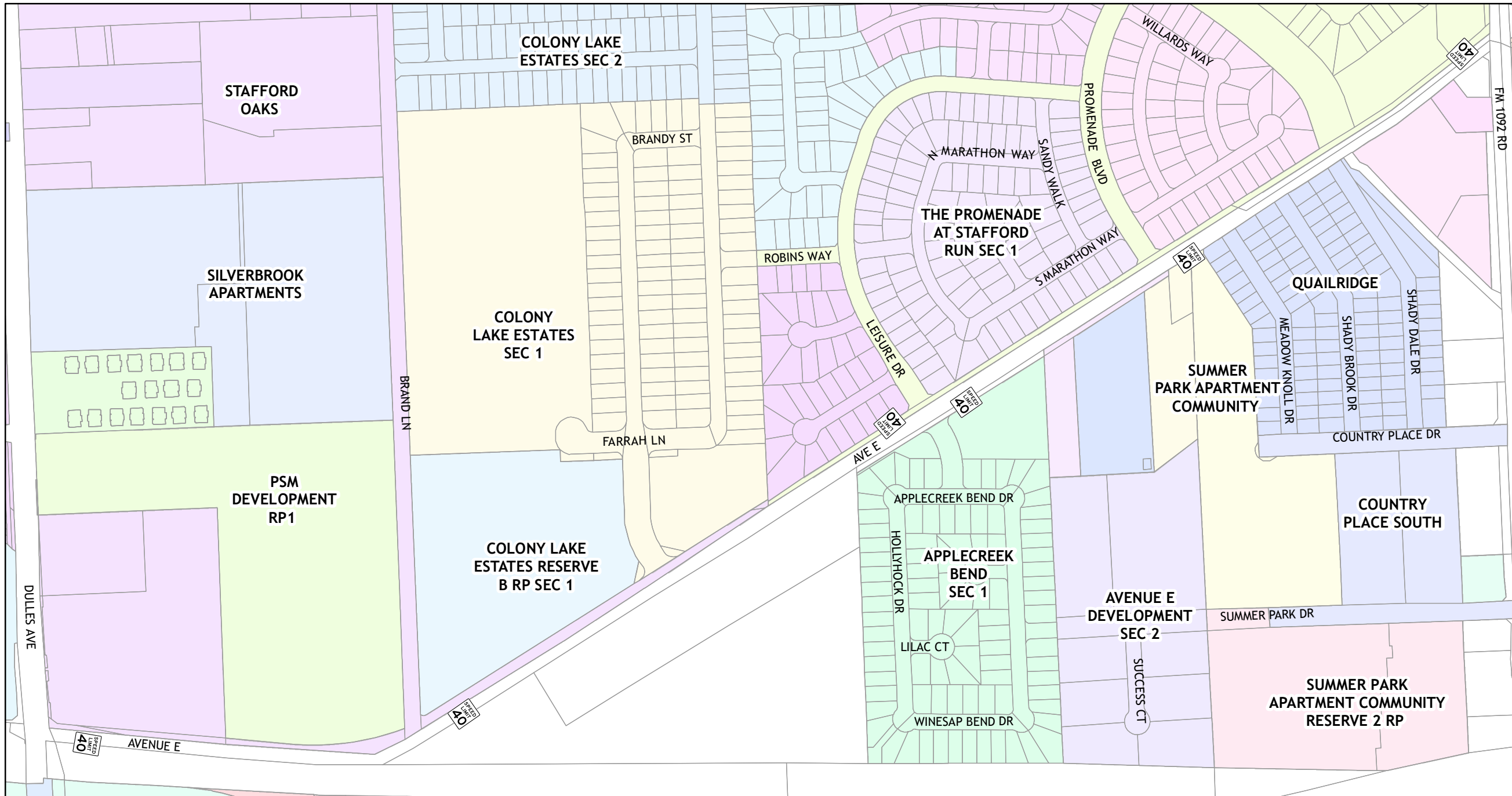
