**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
AGREEMENT FOR FORENSIC LABORATORY TESTING SERVICES
BETWEEN FORT BEND COUNTY AND NMS LABS**

THIS **FIRST AMENDMENT** is made and entered into is entered into by and between Fort Bend County, (hereinafter “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and **NMS LABS** (hereinafter “Contractor”) a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, County and Contractor executed the AGREEMENT FOR FORENSIC LABORATORY TESTING SERVICES BETWEEN FORT BEND COUNTY AND NMS LABS on or about **JUNE 11, 2020** incorporated by reference as if set forth herein verbatim. County and Contractor desire to amend said Agreement as set forth below

- A. The Agreement is hereby renewed; effective **OCTOBER 1, 2020** and shall terminate on **SEPTEMBER 30, 2021**. Terms, conditions and pricing shall remain the same except for as indicated in Exhibit D: Revised Pricing for service year 2020-2021.
- B. For services to be provided from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, County shall pay Contractor a total maximum compensation not to exceed \$196,000.00 (\$186,000 from Medical Examiner and \$10,000 from Sheriff's Office) in accordance with the terms and conditions agreed to in the Agreement and this First Amendment.
- C. Except as modified herein, the Agreement remains in full force and effect and has not been modified or amended.
- D. If there is a conflict among documents, the most recently executed document will prevail with regard to the conflict.
