**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR  
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES**

**THIS SECOND AMENDMENT**, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and RPS, (hereinafter “Contractor”), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Professional Engineering Services on April 23, 2019, (hereinafter “Agreement”) pursuant to SOQ 14-025 and amended by document executed on May 5, 2020, (hereinafter “Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement for additional services to be provided and increase the total Maximum Compensation for the completion of such additional services.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

1. County shall pay Contractor an additional sixty-nine thousand four hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$69,400.00), for additional on-call construction phase and project management services as described in Contractor’s proposal dated August 17, 2020, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein for all purposes.
2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed three hundred sixty-nine thousand four hundred dollars and no/100 (\$369,400.00), authorized as follows:
  - \$200,000.00 under the Agreement;
  - \$100,000.00 under the Amendment; and
  - \$69,400.00 under this Amendment.
3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and this Amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without written agreement executed by both parties.
4. BY ACCEPTANCE OF AGREEMENT, CONTRACTOR ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged.

Dear Mr. Akinwande,

We appreciate the opportunity to work with the County as a Project Manager on the On-Call Construction Phase Services and Project Management for the Trammel Fresno project. We have worked hard to provide exceptional service and to be responsive to your needs. We have nearly expended the fees allocated to us previously and request that additional fee be added to our contract.

We propose adding **\$69,400** to our contract on a time and materials basis. We anticipate the following breakdown of additional project management effort:

- **Utility Coordination** **\$10,080**

  - Project Manager 48 hrs x \$210 = \$10,800
- **Coordination Between Agencies for Punch List (TxDOT & FBC)** **\$8,120**

  - Department Manager 28 hrs x \$280 = \$8,120
- **Right Turn Design Revision on Hurricane/Trammel Fresno (In-Progress)** **\$16,800**

  - Project Manager 30 hrs x \$210 = \$6300
  - Associate Engineer (traffic) 60 hrs x \$130 = \$7800
  - Senior Designer (CAD Technician) 19.29 hrs x \$140 = \$2700
- **Sign Design for Trammel Fresno/all side streets Change Order (In-Progress)** **\$20,000**

  - Senior Project Manager 15 hrs x \$240 = \$3600
  - Project Manager 30 hrs x \$210 = \$6300
  - Associate Engineer (traffic) 60 hrs x \$130 = \$7800
  - Senior Designer (CAD Technician) 16.43 hrs x \$140 = \$2300
- **Hurricane Lane Layout Rev Change Order (Performed in Jan/Feb 2020)** **\$7,800**

  - Senior Project Manager 5 hrs x \$240 = \$1200
  - Project Manager 10 hrs x \$210 = \$2100
  - Associate Engineer (traffic) 30 hrs x \$130 = \$3900
  - Senior Designer (CAD Technician) 4.28 hrs x \$140 = \$600
