**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HB 104 RELATING TO ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION**

**WHEREAS**, Secretary of State shall implement a program to allow a person with an unexpired driver's license or personal identification card issued in the state to complete a voter registration application over the internet from a secure website; and

**WHEREAS**, The website will allow a person to submit an initial application for voter registration and/or update a current voter registration record; and

**WHEREAS**, When a person submits an application under this section, the Secretary of State shall compare applicants information against the Department of Public Safety records; and

**WHEREAS**, A digital signature provided by applicant meets the Secretary of State rules.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:**

THAT ON DECEMBER 15TH, THE **FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**, MEETING AS A BODY IN RICHMOND, TEXAS, ADOPTS THIS RESOLUTION AND URGES THE TEXAS LEGISLATURE ALLOWING INDIVIDUALS TO ELECTRONICALLY REGISTER TO VOTE.
