RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HB 72 RELATING TO THE POWER OF CERTAIN COUNTIES TO ENACT CERTAIN PARK USE RULES

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County owns and operates public parks, but has no authority to enact or enforce regulations in County parks; and

WHEREAS, legislation giving Fort Bend County authority to regulate County Parks and will limit costs associated with vandalism and will make our parks safer for public use; and

WHEREAS, the County should be able to enforce regulations, impose fines, and discourage vandalism and other dangerous activity in its county parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:

THAT ON DECEMBER 15TH, THE **FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**, MEETING AS A BODY IN RICHMOND, TEXAS, ADOPTS THIS RESOLUTION AND URGES THE TEXAS LEGISLATURE PASS LEGISLATION THAT WILL ALLOW FORT BEND COUNTY TO PROTECT COUNTY OWNED PARKS BY ENFORCING REGULATIONS.
