RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HB 52 RELATING TO THE CREATION OF CERTAIN CRIMINAL OFFENSES CONCERNING FIREARM SALES AT GUN SHOWS

WHEREAS, Currently, there are no disincentives for gun dealers to sell guns at a gun show without completing a background check. This loophole in the gun law can allow guns to be purchased by a person at a gun show that would be prohibited from buying a gun in the state of Texas; and

WHEREAS, Supporting HB 52 will close this loophole.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:

THAT ON DECEMBER 15TH, THE **FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**, MEETING AS A BODY IN RICHMOND, TEXAS, ADOPTS THIS RESOLUTION AND URGES THE TEXAS LEGISLATURE TO CREATE CERTAIN CRIMINAL OFFENSES CONCERNING FIREARM SALES AT GUN SHOWS.
