Fort Bend County Engineering respectfully requests modifications to the Fort Bend County Major Thoroughfare Plan (MTP) at the request of the LJA Engineering, on behalf of the Caldwell Ranch Subdivision. The requested modifications are as follows:

- **Sienna Parkway extension** remove the proposed major thoroughfare from FM 521 to the Fort Bend/Brazoria County line.
- Caldwell Ranch Boulevard upgrade Caldwell Ranch Boulevard from to a Collector from FM 521 to the Fort Bend/Brazoria County line.
- **Southern Colony Avenue** upgrade Southern Colony Avenue to a Collector from FM 521 to the Fort Bend/Brazoria County line.

On behalf of our client, LJA Engineering respectfully submits the above major throughfare plan amendment request for your review and presentation to the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court.

Attached is an exhibit indicating the major throughfare plan amendment request, which shows the existing plan with the proposed amendments. The plan is proposing the removal of major thoroughfare in question and the addition of four collector roads on the Fort Bend County Major Thoroughfare Plan as shown on the attached exhibit and as detailed below. The area being referenced is east of FM 521, west of State Highway 288, north of County Road 57, and south of State Highway 6. The proposed amendments are all located east of FM 521.

- Remove the east/west thoroughfare named Sienna Parkway east of FM 521 that extends to the Fort Bend County and Brazoria County boundary
- Add an east/west collector located within the Caldwell Ranch development that extends east from FM 521 to the Fort Bend County and Brazoria County boundary and connects to the existing County Road 573 Alloy Road
- Add an east/west collector named Southern Colony Avenue that will extend east from FM 521 to and tie into the Brazoria County proposed major thoroughfare named County Road 81 Bullard Road
- Add an east/west collector named Glendale Lakes Drive located within the Glendale Lakes development that extends east from the Fort Bend County and Brazoria County boundary and connects to existing County Road 956




