Applicant: Winnebago County Forest Preserve District Police, Rockford, Illinois

The purpose of this program is to enhance law enforcement's capacity to prevent, solve, and control crime by providing funds for the hiring of additional officers. The Winnebago County Forest Preserve District Police requested and received \$125,000 to hire one additional sworn officer to create flexibility in the schedule to allow for more police presence on the preserves in the after-hours and off months. The additional officer was requested to address ongoing issues with vandalism and destruction of preserves property. A local match of \$116,527 was

provided to meet the remainder of the project cost.

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
