Riding a bike is not as easy as...riding a bike. Public safety cyclists must learn how to ride both technically and tactically. This intense course will equip you with the skills to teach public safety cyclists how to use their bikes safely and effectively. Through in-class presentations, on-bike drills, mock teaching sessions, and peer and self-critiques, you will learn to identify and correct improper technique; assist students in overcoming difficulties; and incorporate various methods of instruction into the IPMBA courses. This course is often described by graduates as one of the most challenging and rewarding classes of their careers.

No refunds after November 12. If the course is cancelled, participants will be offered the choice of a refund or credit for the registration fee of \$825.

BORROW A BIKE!

ASU Police has 30 department bicycles, all in good working order, ranging in size from XS to XXL. Most are Volcanic 29ers with 1x drive trains, but they also have several 26'ers and Trek 29ers. They will be made available for loan on a first-come, first-served basis.

Most have platform pedals; there are a few with toe clips, but we recommend bringing your own pedals. The bikes are equipped with kickstands and Topeak Explorer racks with QuickTrack and are compatible with any MTX TrunkBag. ASU Police cannot guarantee trunk bags, so if you have one, please bring it. You must bring your own headlight and taillight. EMS personnel must provide their own equipment and carrying system. Contact Larry (mailto:larry.fuchtman@asu.edu) to reserve.

BIKE SHIPPING

High-quality, affordable bike shipping services are available through Bike Flights (https://www.bikeflights.com/partners/international-police-mountain-bike-association).

For assembly/disassembly/repacking services (\$175 labor; repairs and parts billed separately), contact Landis Cyclery (https://www.landiscyclery.com/about/tempe-north-pg406.htm) at 480-839-9383. Schedule the delivery date at least three business days prior to the course to allow time for assembly. Allow several days after the course for disassembly and repacking in addition to return shipping time. Print a return label when scheduling your shipment via UPS or FEDEX or arranging shipping via Bike Flights.

Domenic's is located approximately four miles/6.45 km from the training location. Hours: Monday-Friday 10:00am-7:00pm, Saturday 9:00am-6:00pm, Sunday 11:00am-4:00pm.

Schedule your service **at least three weeks in advance** and advise Larry (mailto:larry.fuchtman@asu.edu) that you are shipping your bike to the shop so he can arrange to pick it up and deliver it to the ASU Police Station. It is possible that the ASU Student Government Bike Coop will be open by December and able to provide free assembly/disassembly for shipped bicycles. Check with Larry after September 1st to confirm.

Address the shipment as follows:

Include your arrival date on the package. The bikes will be delivered to the ASU Police Station prior to the class and picked up for return shipping.

If you are staying at the Graduate Hotel and wish to assemble, disassemble, and repack your own bike, you may ship it to yourself to arrive no more than two business days prior to your arrival. Check with the hotel regarding their shipping policies/fees. You will need to arrange return shipping through the hotel. Pre-printing return labels is recommended.

WAIVER/RELEASE OF LIABILITY


