This message is to inform you that your proposal, 2022-FBCoCP4-S-1YG-00134 has been approved for funding.

TxDOT Traffic Safety grant agreements must be electronically/digitally signed by both parties. You must read and follow the "Electronic Signature Agreement" instructions on the eGrantsHelp page for detailed steps on how to electronically sign your grant agreements in eGrants.

Please note that this award is contingent upon Highway Safety Plan (HSP) approval by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), and the availability of federal funds awarded to the State of Texas under the provisions of the HSP and upon Internal Compliance Program review clearance of your agency by TxDOT Compliance division.

According to the General Services Administration (GSA), in 2022 there will be a "new, non-proprietary identifier" that will replace the D-U-N-S® number called the Unique Entity Identifier, or the UEI. The UEI will be requested in, and assigned by, the System for Award Management (SAM.gov). Although the UEI will not replace the DUNS number until April 2022, TxDOT will require it's subgrantees to provide their UEI before FY 2022 grants are executed in eGrants. To obtain a UEI number, applicants should go to the SAM.gov website at <https://sam.gov/content/entity-registration>. FY 2022 grants will not be executed without this information.

Also, please be mindful that the grant becomes effective on Oct 01, 2021, or on the date of final signature by both parties, whichever is later. No costs can be incurred prior to the effective date of the grant.
