**SIXTH AMENDMENT TO PROJECT MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT FOR
THE 2017 FORT BEND COUNTY MOBILITY BOND PROGRAM**

THIS SIXTH AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and **RPS INFRASTRUCTURE, INC.**, (hereinafter “Project Manager”), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Project Management Agreement for the 2017 Fort Bend County Mobility Bond Program on March 13, 2018, (hereinafter “Agreement”), as amended by documents executed on November 5, 2019, (hereinafter “Amendment”), May 27, 2020, (hereinafter “Second Amendment”), October 6, 2020, (hereinafter “Third Amendment”), February 2, 2021, (hereinafter “Fourth Amendment”), and June 8, 2021, (hereinafter “Fifth Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement for additional services to be provided and increase the total Maximum Compensation under the Agreement for the completion of such additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

1. County shall pay Project Manager an additional twenty-one thousand one hundred dollars and no/100 (\$21,100.00), for the Services as described in Project Manager’s Proposal for Supplemental Services dated July 28, 2021, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein for all purposes.
2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Project Manager for Services to be rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed two million five hundred twelve thousand five hundred ninety-five dollars and no/100 (\$2,512,595.00), authorized as follows:
 - \$1,000,000.00 under the Agreement
 - \$187,000.00 under the Amendment;
 - \$310,000.00 under the Second Amendment;
 - \$300,750.00; under the Third Amendment;
 - \$293,750.00 under the Fourth Amendment;
 - \$399,995.00 under the Fifth Amendment; and
 - \$21,100.00 under this Sixth Amendment.
3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and any amendment thereof exceed the Maximum Compensation without written agreement executed by both parties.

4. BY ACCEPTANCE OF AGREEMENT, PROJECT MANAGER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement and any subsequently executed amendment shall remain unchanged.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the County and the Project Manager have caused their respective duly authorized representatives to execute, seal and deliver this Sixth Amendment, all as of the date signed by the last party hereto.

We have expended the fees allocated to us previously and would like to request an additional fee be added to our contract.

We propose adding **\$21,100** to our contract on a time and materials basis. We anticipate the following breakdown of additional project management effort.

Sundial Park Project Scoping (Task Completed) \$ 1,020

- Project Manager 3 hrs. x \$210 = \$ 630
- Associate Engineer (traffic) 3 hrs. x \$130 = \$ 390

California Street and Trammel Fresno Project Scoping (Task Completed) \$ 6,350

- Project Manager 16 hrs. x \$210 = \$ 3,360
- Associate Engineer (traffic) 9 hrs. x \$130 = \$ 1,170
- Senior Designer (CADD Technician) 13 hrs. x \$140 = \$ 1,820

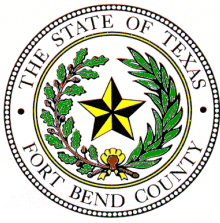
