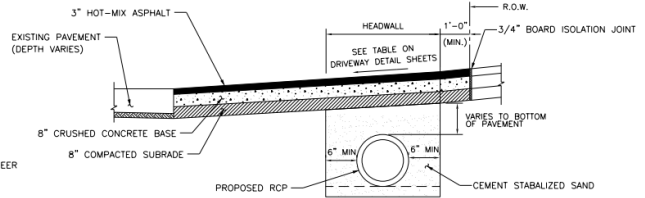


OPEN DITCH DRIVEWAY

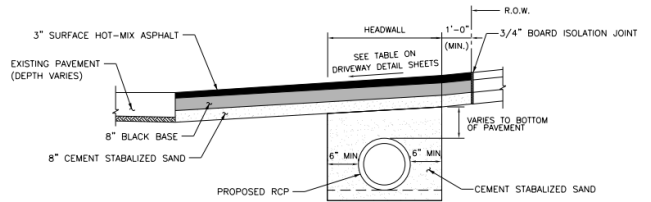
