The Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed a review of the operational conditions along Westheimer Parkway between Greenbusch Road and the Harris County line. The roadway currently has a posted speed of 35 mph and is identified as a Major Thoroughfare in the 2015 Fort Bend County Major Thoroughfare Plan.

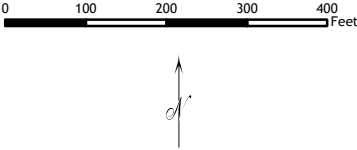




Westheimer Pkwy. between Greenbusch Rd. and Harris County (Sheet 3 of 9)

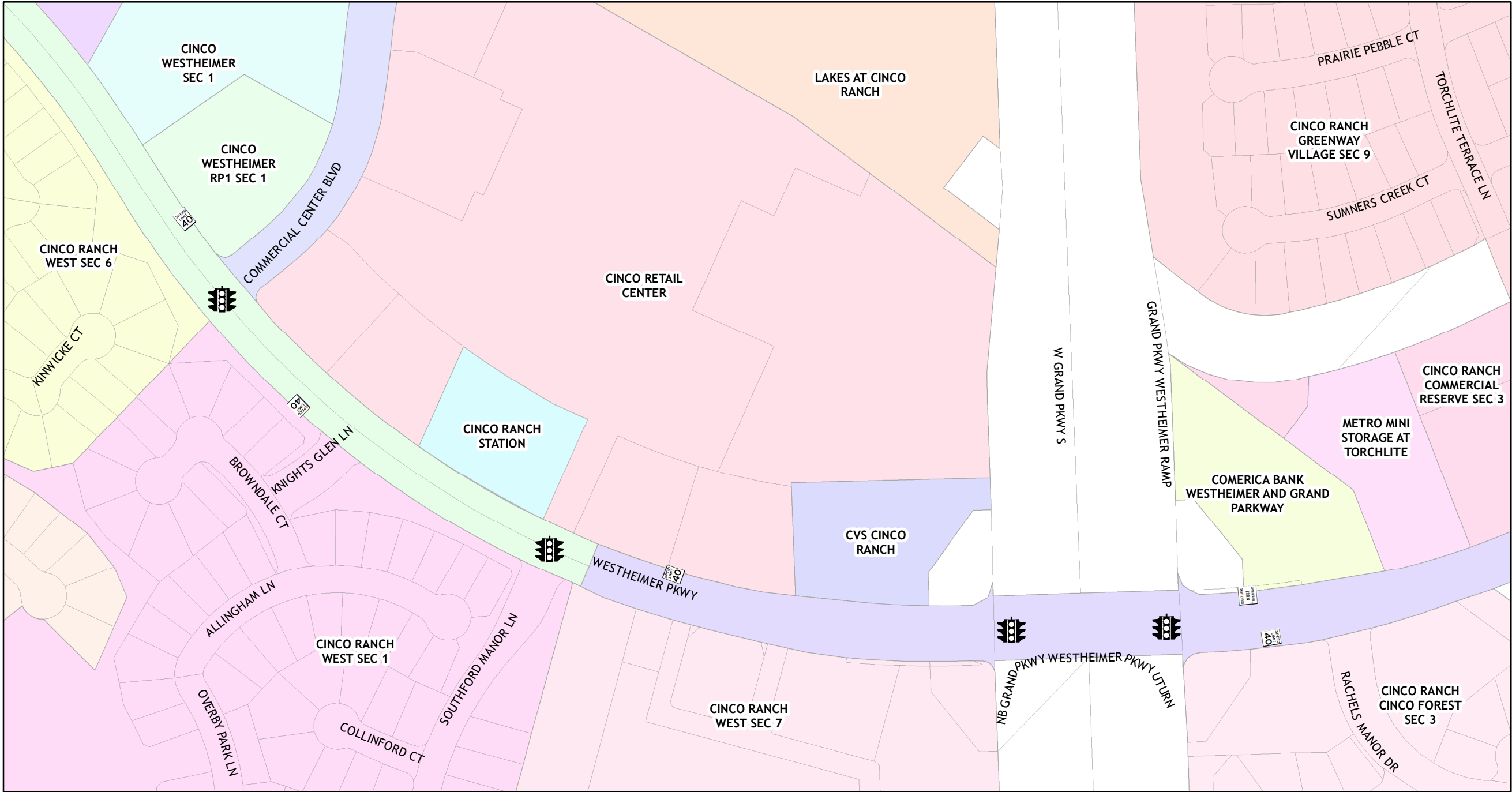

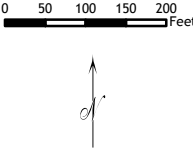

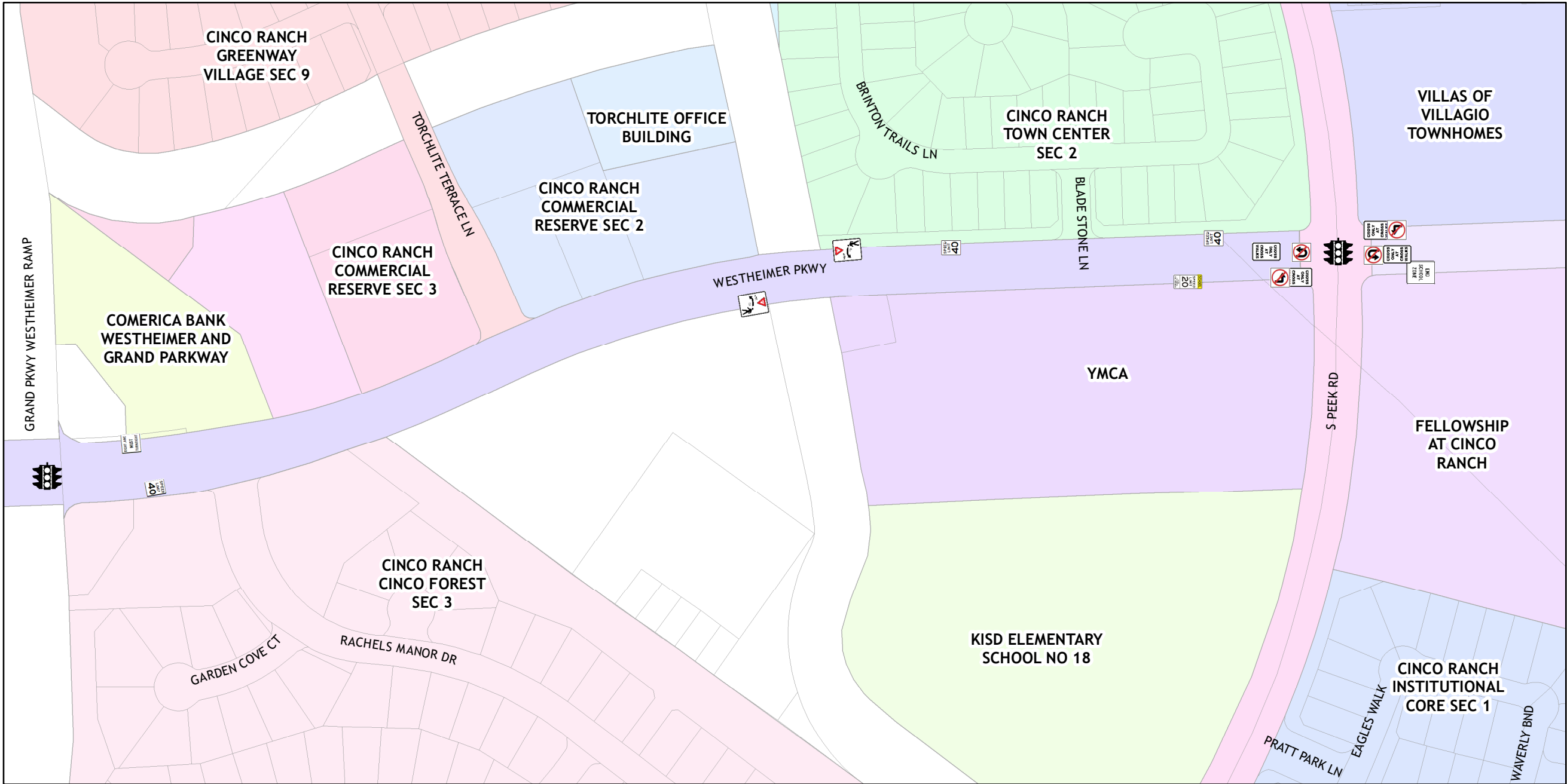
Westheimer Pkwy. between Greenbusch Rd. and Harris County (Sheet 4 of 9)

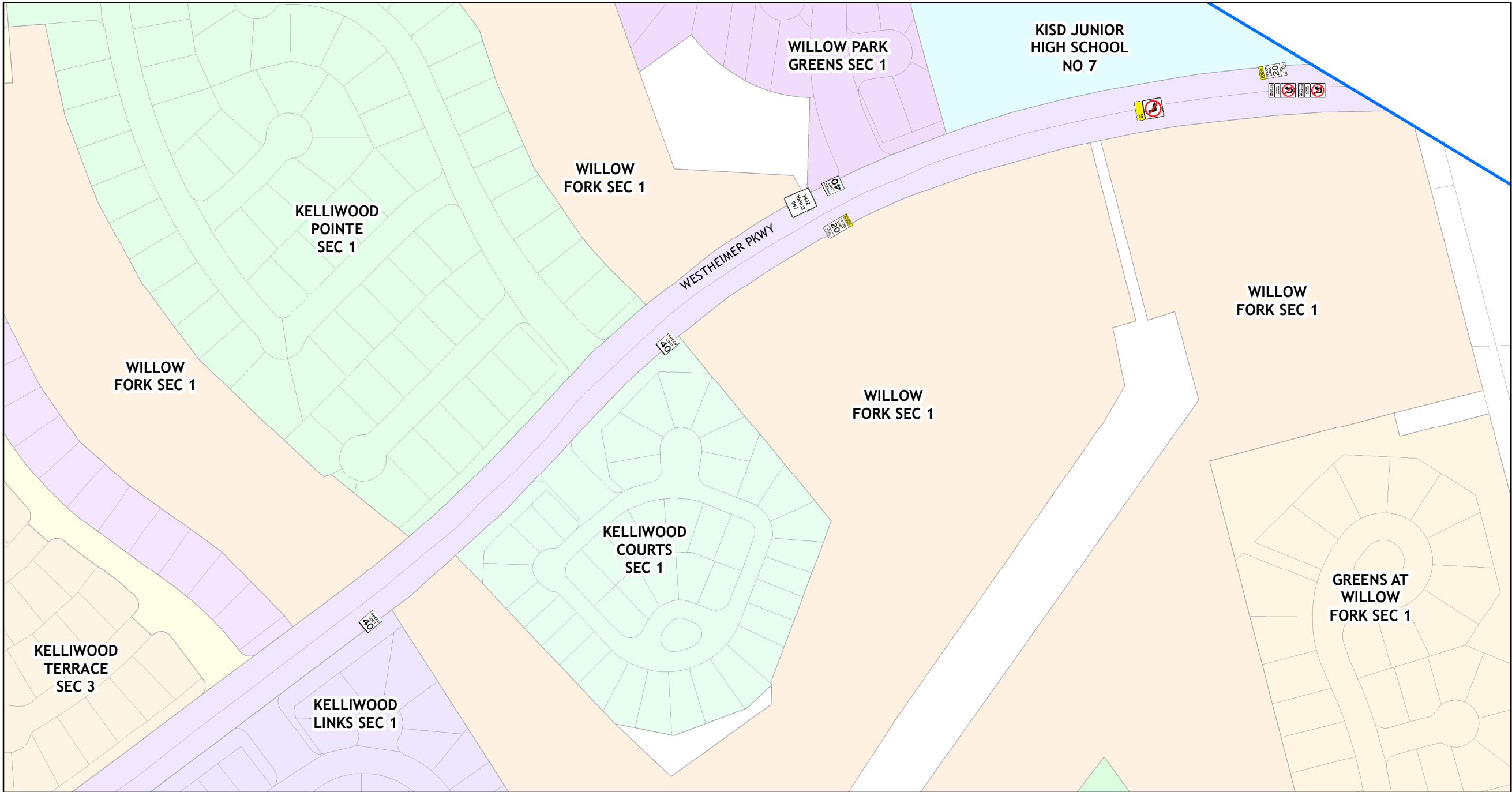
