**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE INFANT TODDLER COURT: HEALING THE
YOUNGEST VICTIMS PROJECT # 3334305 GRANT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County desires to continue to provide trauma healing services to young victims of abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to continue to support the **Infant Toddler Court: Healing the Youngest Victims Project**; and

WHEREAS, the County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the Fort Bend County area, that the **Infant Toddler Court: Healing the Youngest Victims Project** funded through the Texas Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, be operated for the **2022-2023** fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County agrees to provide all applicable support for the grant application to be submitted to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division before or on February 10, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division funds, Fort Bend County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County designates the Honorable Judge KP George, County Judge of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court, as the County's authorized official giving him the power to electronically apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Fort Bend County approves submission of the grant application for the **Infant Toddler Court: Healing the Youngest Victims Project** to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division for an amount not to exceed **\$48,884.52** with no local match.
