At the request of neighborhood residents, Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed the traffic control plan to prohibit parking, stopping, and standing on: both sides of Camille Park Drive, both sides of Legacy Oaks Drive, and the south side of Largo Oaks Drive. This prohibition will be in effect only on school days, 7:15 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:15 to 4:30 p.m. The public hearing date for acceptance for the plan will be scheduled on the next available Commissioner's Court Agenda.

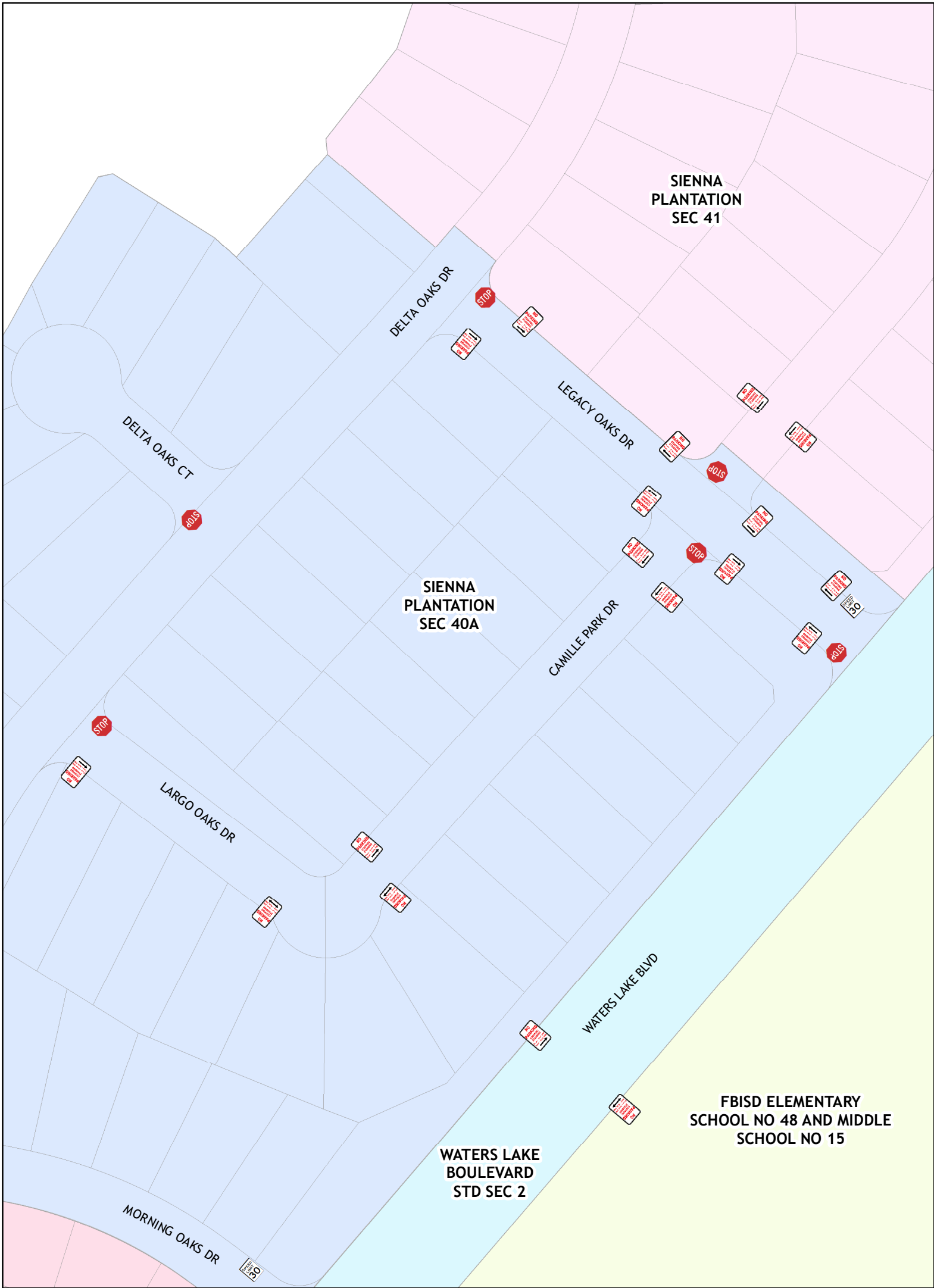

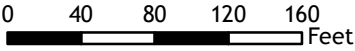
