I hereby donate \$13,000 for the sole purpose of purchasing a Dual Purpose Narcotics Detection Canine for the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office.

It is a condition of my donation that upon retirement of the K-9 or any other circumstance resulting in the ceased duty of the K-9, the K-9 shall be retired as follows:

- First with the current handler as determined by the Sheriff, or
- If the above handler is unavailable or unable to adopt the K-9, then to Sandra Varghese (myself), to the extend allowed by law.

If I (Sandra Varghese) is unavailable or unable to adopt the K-9, the K-9 shall be adopted in accordance with Texas Government Code Section 614.213, or the existing state law in effect at the time of transfer, whichever is more current.
