FOURTH AMENDMENT TO WORK AUTHORIZATION NO. 6 TO AGREEMENT FOR PARK AND RIDE FACILITY PLANNING AND CONSULTING SERVICES SOQ 09-072

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and IDCUS, (formerly known as IDC, Inc., hereinafter "Engineer" or "Contractor"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Professional Engineering Services Agreement on January 26, 2010 (hereinafter "Agreement") for preliminary planning activities for park and ride facilities located in Fort Bend County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the parties executed Work Authorization No. 6 on or about December 15, 2020, and as amended on February 2, 2021, March 23, 2021, and June 22, 2021 incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the following changes are incorporated as if a part of the original Agreement incorporated by reference in the same as if fully set forth verbatim herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

- 1. The time for performance of Services shall be extended for additional period of time ending on December 31, 2023, unless extended by further agreement of the parties.
- 2. Exhibit B of the Agreement will "Revised Work Schedule" will be replaced with the attached "Revised Work Schedule-April 2022".
- 3. <u>Certain State Law Requirements for Contracts:</u> The contents of this Section are required by Texas Law and are included by County regardless of content.
 - a. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor does not boycott energy companies and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott energy companies during the term of such contracts. "Boycott energy company" has the meaning provided in section 809.001 of the Texas Government Code.
 - b. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor does not have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association during the

term of such contracts. "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association" has the meaning provided in section 2274.001(3) of the Texas Government Code. "Firearm entity" and "firearm trade association" have the meanings provided in section 2274.001(6) and (7) of the Texas Government Code.

4. All terms and conditions of the Agreement, including any addenda or amendments, not modified herein shall remain in full force and effect for the term of the Agreement. If there is a conflict between this Fourth Amendment and the Agreement for Professional Services, the provisions of this Fourth Amendment shall prevail with regard to the conflict.
