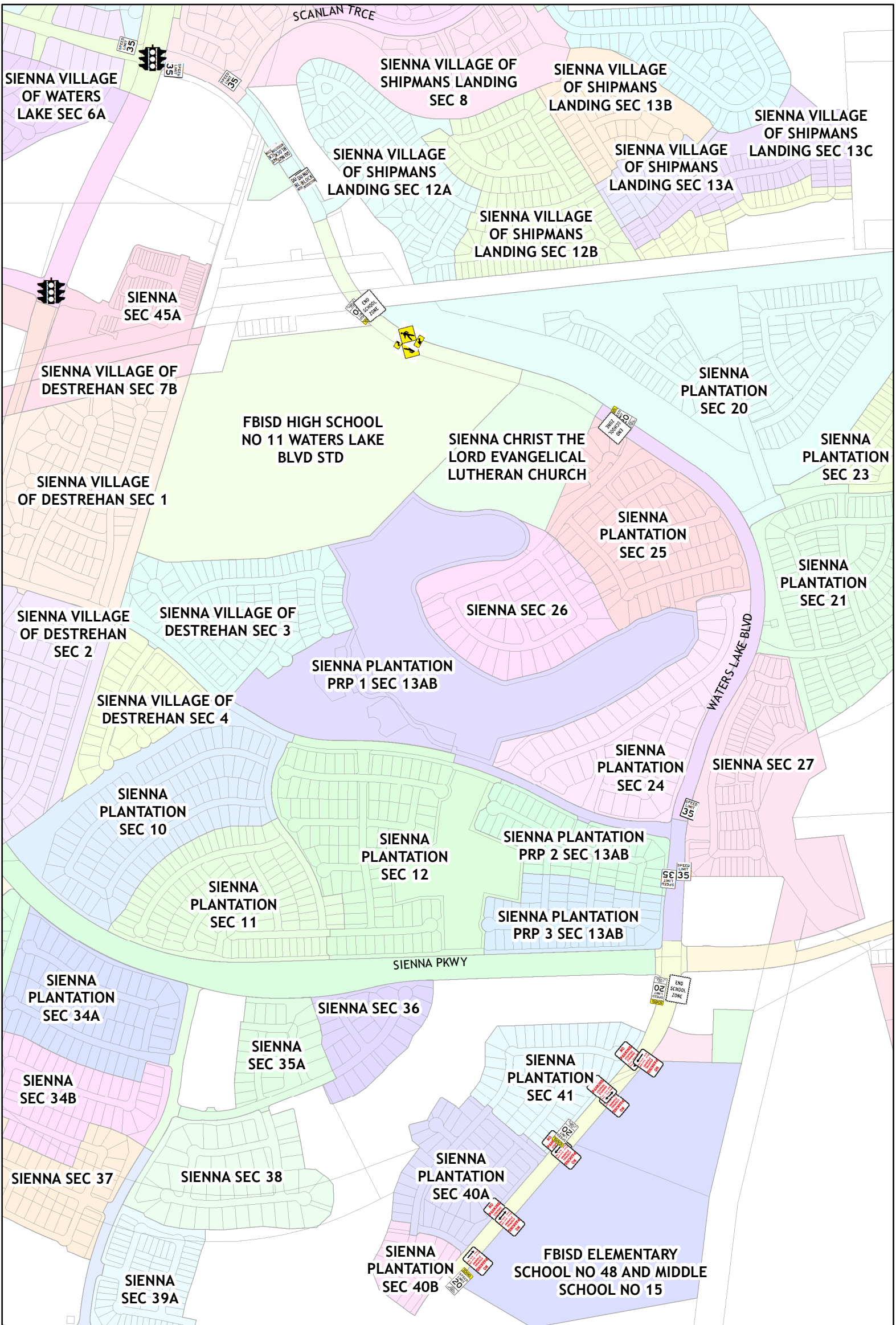
The Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed a review of the operational conditions along Waters Lake Boulevard between Sienna Parkway (northern intersection) and its current southern termination at Morning Oaks Drive. The roadway currently has a posted speed of 30 mph and is identified as a Major Thoroughfare in the 2015 Fort Bend County Major Thoroughfare Plan.
