ORDER OF FORT BEND COUNTY TO CREATE FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 9, THE LEVY BY SAID DISTRICT OF A TAX NOT TO EXCEED THE LIMITS OF THE TEXAS CONSTITUTION AFTER AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF THE MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST IN AN ELECTION HELD ON MAY 7, 2022 FAVORED CREATION OF THE DISTRICT AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 775.019 AND OTHER RELEVANT PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 775, TEXAS HEALTH & SAFETY CODE

WHEREAS, at an election held on the 7th day of May, 2022 in that part of Fort Bend County, State of Texas, described with the applicable boundaries attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, "Boundaries of the Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9"; there was submitted to the qualified voters the question of whether that territory should be formed into an emergency services district under state law; and

WHEREAS, at the Election, votes were cast as follows:

WHEREAS, the formation of the emergency services district and the imposition of a tax not to exceed the rate allowed by Section 48-e, Article III, Texas Constitution received the affirmative vote of the majority of the votes cast at the election as provided by law;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS THAT THE TRACT DESCRIBED ABOVE IN THIS ORDER, HAS BEEN DULY AND LEGALLY FORMED, SAVE AND EXCEPT THE PORTIONS OF THE ABOVE DESCRIPTION THAT INCLUDE THE CITY OF ROSENBERG'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION AS THAT AREA EXISTED ON MAY 7, 2022, INTO AN EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT UNDER THE NAME OF "FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 9" UNDER ARTICLE III, SECTION 48-E, OF THE TEXAS CONSTITUTION AS PROPOSED BY S.J.R. NO. 27, ACTS OF THE 70TH LEGISLATURE, REGULAR SESSION 1987, AND ADOPTED BY THE VOTERS AT AN ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 3, 1987, AND HAS THE POWERS VESTED BY LAW IN THE DISTRICT INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPOSITION OF A TAX NOT TO EXCEED THE RATE ALLOWED BY SECTION 48-E, ARTICLE III, TEXAS CONSTITUTION.

Exhibit “A”

Description of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9

Boundary Description

Beginning at the point of intersection of the Fort Bend-Wharton County line with the southernmost corner of the boundary of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 8, thence north and easterly along the boundary of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 8 to the point of intersection with the boundary of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 6, thence south and easterly along the boundary of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 6 to the point of intersection with eastern right-of-way line of State Highway 36, thence southerly along the eastern right-of-way line of State Highway 36 to the point of intersection with the northeast right-of-way line of Jeske Road, thence south and easterly along the northeast right-of-way line of Jeske Road to the point of intersection with the northwest right-of-way line of Roesler Road, thence north and easterly along the northwest right-of-way line of Roesler Road to the point of intersection with the northeast right-of-way line of Oberrender/Zamanek Road, thence south and easterly along the northeast right-of-way line of Zamanek Road to the point of intersection with the northwestern right-of-way line of FM 1994; then north and easterly along the northwest right-of-way line of FM 1994 to the point of intersection with the northeast right-of-way line of Davis Estate Road extended across FM 1994; thence easterly along the north right-of-way line of Davis Estate Road to the point of intersection with the west right-of-way line of Tadpole Road/County Road 762; thence northerly along the west right-of-way line of Tadpole Road/County Road 762 to the point of intersection with the north right-of-way line of Sawmill Road extended across Tadpole Road/County Road 762, thence easterly along the north right-of-way line of Sawmill Road to the point of intersection with the north property line of that certain 2188.48 acre tract owned by the State of Texas in the Barrett & Harris Survey and known as Brazos Bend State Park, thence easterly along the north boundary line of Brazos Bend State Park to the Fort Bend-Brazoria County Line, thence southerly and westerly along the Fort Bend-Brazoria County Line to the point of intersection of the Fort-Bend Brazoria County Line with the Fort Bend-Wharton County Line; thence north and westerly along the Fort Bend-Wharton County Line to the point of beginning.

SAVE AND EXCEPT the portions of the above description that include the City of Rosenberg's extraterritorial jurisdiction as that area existed on May 7, 2022.
