The proposed single family development of Fulshear Lakes Creekside Section 3 consists of 25.116 acres of land with 99 Lots, 5 Reserves in 5 Blocks. This final plat was approved on December 14, 2021 by the City of Fulshear City Council Commission.

We respectfully request the Court to consider granting the following:

A variance to the maximum 800 foot length requirement for dead-end streets that finish with a permanent cul-de-sac established under Section 5.6(A)(2) of the Fort Bend County Regulations of Subdivisions and allow the street Red Shiner Way to exceed 800 feet in order to provide connectivity between the end of the cul-de-sac and the future trail along Fulshear Lakes Way, which is part of the reason for the reserve currently shown within the proposed development area.

We respectfully request the Court to consider granting the following:

A variance to the minimum 70 foot Right-of-Way width requirement for Major Collector roads established under Section 5.3.B(1) of the Fort Bend County Regulations of Subdivisions and allow the street Fulshear Lakes Way Right-of-Way width to be 60 feet based on an agreement between FBC MUD 216 and the City, the minimum City requirements in this case would be 60'. I've attached the relevant exhibit from the agreement within the proposed development area.
