SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ESTABLISHING A TOLL RATE SCHEDULE FOR
THE FORT BEND PARKWAY AND WESTPARK TOLLWAY

BACKGROUND

The Fort Bend County Toll Road Authority (“Authority”) is operating the Fort Bend Parkway and Westpark Tollway Toll Roads (collectively, “Toll Roads”) on behalf of Fort Bend County; and

The Authority desires to amend the established toll rate schedules on the Fort Bend Parkway Toll Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

The Amended and Restated Order Establishing a Toll Rate Schedule for the Fort Bend County Toll Road System; Prohibiting the Operation of a Motor Vehicle on the Road System After Failure to Pay Required Toll or Charge; Establishing an Administrative Adjudication Hearing Procedure for Violation of this Order; Containing Other Provisions Relating to the Subject dated September 27, 2022 is hereby supplemented as follows:

Section 3. Toll Rates; Toll Payment Required.

Effective as of January 1, 2023, the required toll at each toll plaza of the Fort Bend Parkway and Westpark Tollway is established as those tolls and charges shown on **Exhibit A**.

For the calendar year 2023, Tolls for Toll Tag and non-Toll Tag transactions on the Fort Bend Parkway and Westpark Tollway were adjusted to reflect an average of the annual changes for the past five years in the Consumer Price Index All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) Houston-Galveston-Brazoria, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics for the month of August, and rounded to the nearest cent.
