

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FORT BEND COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

2023 PROPOSED GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA
FOR TAX ABATEMENTS**

Notice is hereby given that Fort Bend County Drainage District will consider taking action on the Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements at their regular meeting to be held on **Tuesday, May 9, 2023, at 1:00p.m.**

The 2023 Proposed Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements are effective for two years from the date adopted, and before a governing body can adopt, amend, repeal, or reauthorize those guidelines, members of the public are provided an opportunity to be heard at a public hearing, pursuant to Chapter 312 of the Texas Tax Code, Sections 312.002(c) and 312.002 (c-1)

The Fort Bend County Economic Opportunity & Development Office serves as the compliance authority for the Tax Abatement agreements. Because of this compliance role, The Director of Fort Bend County Economic Opportunity & Development will be providing input concerning the Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements to be adopted, along with the Fort Bend County Drainage District and the General Public.

The 2023 Proposed Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements to be considered by the Drainage District will be included in the Commissioners Court regular meeting date of **May 9, 2023**. This notice does not replace any notice required for open meetings under Texas Government Code Section 551 but is in addition to any other notice required by law.
