RESOLUTION NOMINATING CANDIDATE FOR THE  
2024-2025 CANDIDATE FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
FORT BEND CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT  
BY THE FORT BEND COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT  
SECTION 6.03(H) OF THE TEXAS PROPERTY TAX CODE

WHEREAS, the Fort Bend Central Drainage District (the “Drainage District”) was created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, for the reclamation and drainage of the district's overflowed lands and other lands needing drainage;

WHEREAS, the Fort Bend Central Appraisal District (the “Appraisal District”) is responsible for the appraisal of all taxable property within Fort Bend County governed by a board of directors;

WHEREAS, the five directors are appointed by the taxing units that participate in the Appraisal District;

WHEREAS, the Drainage District is a taxing unit per Texas Special District Local Laws Code Section 6604.151; and

WHEREAS, the Drainage District is entitled to vote and select the Drainage District’s nominee to the Appraisal District Board from the nominating ballot provided to the Drainage District by the Appraisal District chief appraiser and submit the results before August 15; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution memorializes the vote take by the Fort Bend County Drainage District in accordance with Section 6.03(k) of the Texas Property Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, the Appraisal District Board will receive this Resolution from the Drainage District as part of the count of the votes from all participating taxing units, and declare the five candidates who receive the largest cumulative vote totals elected, and

WHEREAS, the names provided for voting consideration by, and the number of votes allotted to, the Drainage District in this Resolution were provided to the Drainage District by the Appraisal District chief appraiser (as attached as Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bend County Drainage District finds that this Resolution serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Fort Bend County Drainage District casts the allotted 24 votes as stated below, for nomination to serve on the Board of Directors of the Fort Bend Central Appraisal District
