A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE (GLO) FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - MITIGATION (CDBG-MIT) REGIONAL METHOD OF DISTRUBUTION (MOD) PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER(S) AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT — MITIGATION (CDBG-MIT) PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Hurricane Harvey (DR-4332) severely impacted the Fort Bend County; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County desires to increase resilience to disasters and reduce or eliminate the long-term risk of loss of life, injury, damage to and loss of property, and suffering and hardship, by lessening the impact of future disasters; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County desires a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County aims to Affirmatively Further Fair Housing by identifying projects that overcome or do not increase patterns of residential segregation based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability, or family status;

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Fort Bend County to apply for funding under the Community Development Block Grant – Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) Regional Method of Distribution (MOD) Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISIONER'S COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY:

- 1. That a Community Development Block Grant Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) Regional Method of Distribution (MOD) program application is hereby authorized to be filed by Fort Bend County with the General Land Office for the mitigation efforts under the Regional Mitigation Program.
- 2. That the five (5) projects detailed within the application will make Flood and Drainage improvements throughout Fort Bend County, which were identified as a risk due to Hurricanes/Tropical Storms/Tropical Depressions and Riverine Flooding, thereby placing undue and certain health and safety risks on residents.
- 3. That the CDBG-MIT Application request amount be filed for **\$56,030,000.00**.
- 4. That the application requires a local contribution in the amount of **\$4,063,600.00** to be allocated by the City of Sugar Land with their CDBG-MIT Regional MOD application.
- 5. That the total project cost is **\$60,093,600.00** to include construction, engineering, and administration services.
