Project Management (DEC)

- Participated in conference calls with to coordinate project activities.
- Completed design and plan production toward 100% PS&E submittal to TxDOT Division (Austin) in June. Addressed comments as they were received from TxDOT and RPS.

Environmental Studies (SWCA)

Received NEPA clearance on 03/01.

Survey (Weisser)

Continued development of TxDOT ROW Maps.

Geotechnical (Aviles)

None.

PS&E Design (DEC)

- Addressed TxDOT and RPS comments on the final PS&E design, including Retaining Wall plans, Sound Wall Plans, Index of Sheets, and Drainage design.
- Per direction from RPS, removed direct connector from design and updated plans accordingly.
- Provided updated plans to RPS on 12/01 for submittal to Austin.

<u>Drainage PS&E Design</u> (Sirrus)

- Reviewed drainage study provided by TxDOT's consultants RPS/CivilTech.
- Met with RPS on 11/09 to discuss detention pond alternatives. Detention pond will not be included in the plan set issued for construction but will be added later.
- Received design from RPS to drain frontage road trunk line across SH 99 as an interim condition until pond design is finalized. Updated plans accordingly.
- Continued development of drainage report requested by TxDOT.

- Reviewed permits from CenterPoint Electric, CenterPoint gas, and telecoms for potential conflicts with SBFR project.
