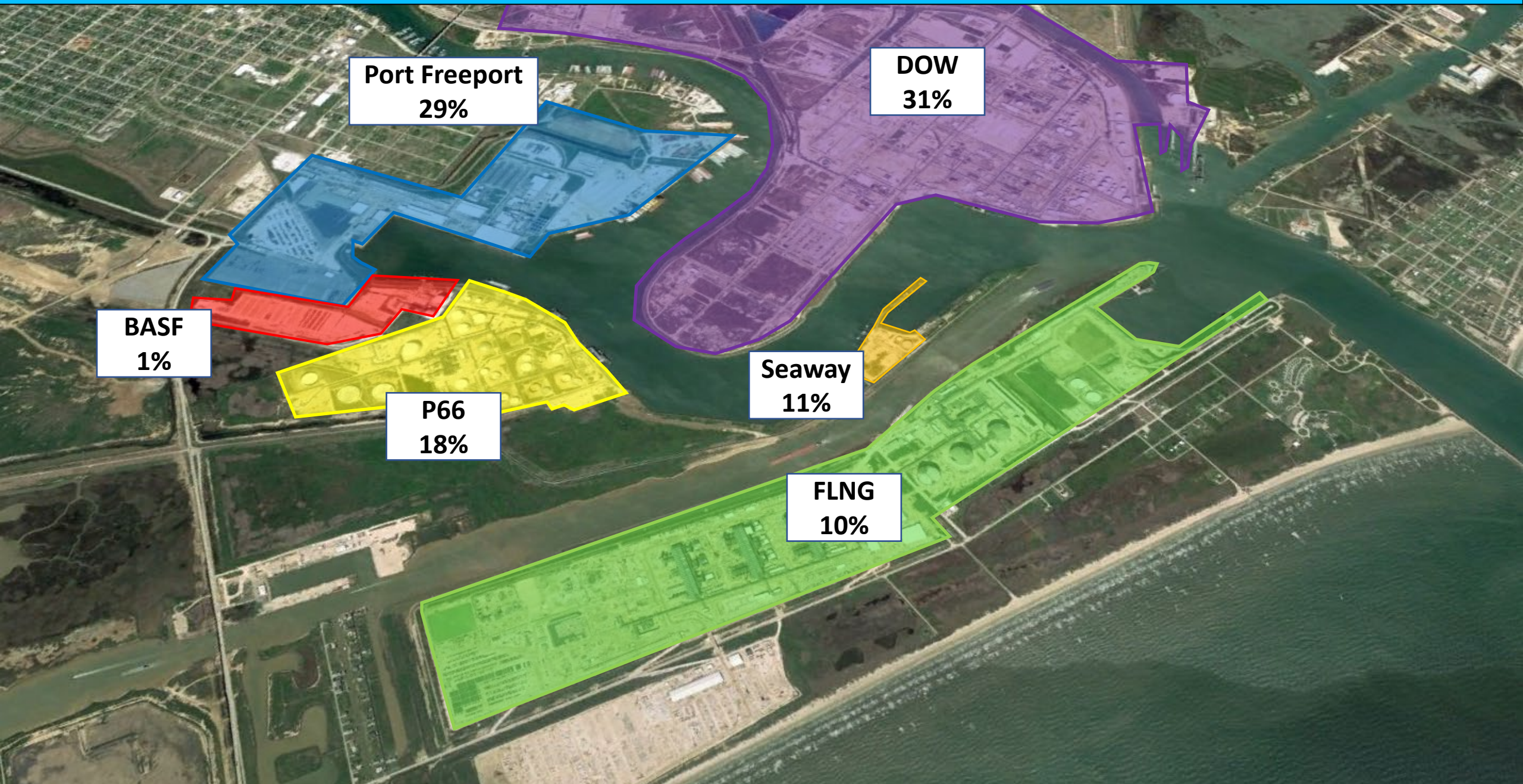


Port-wide Vessels and Tonnage

- Ranked 6th in U.S. Chemicals

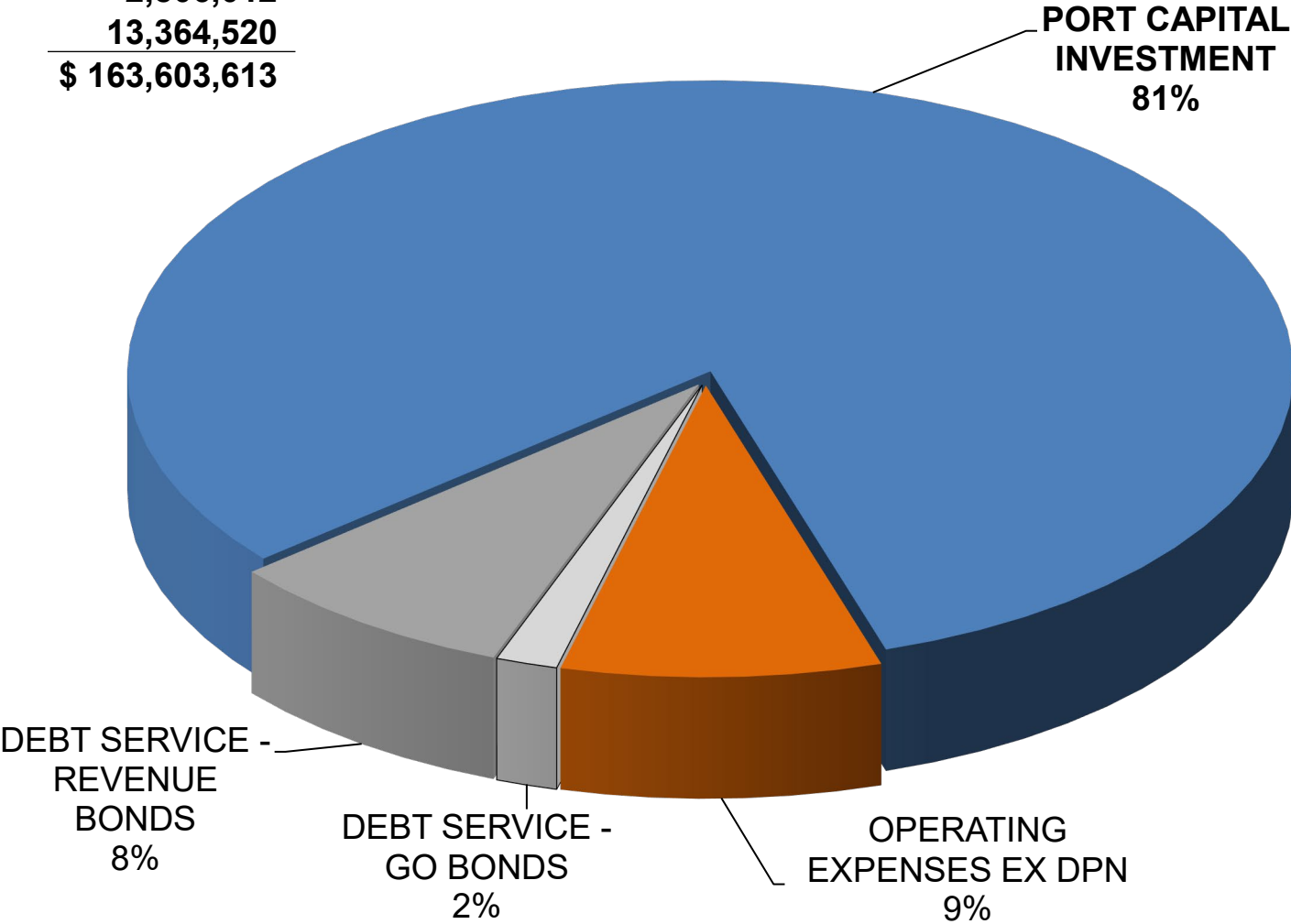


Vessel Arrivals by Terminal

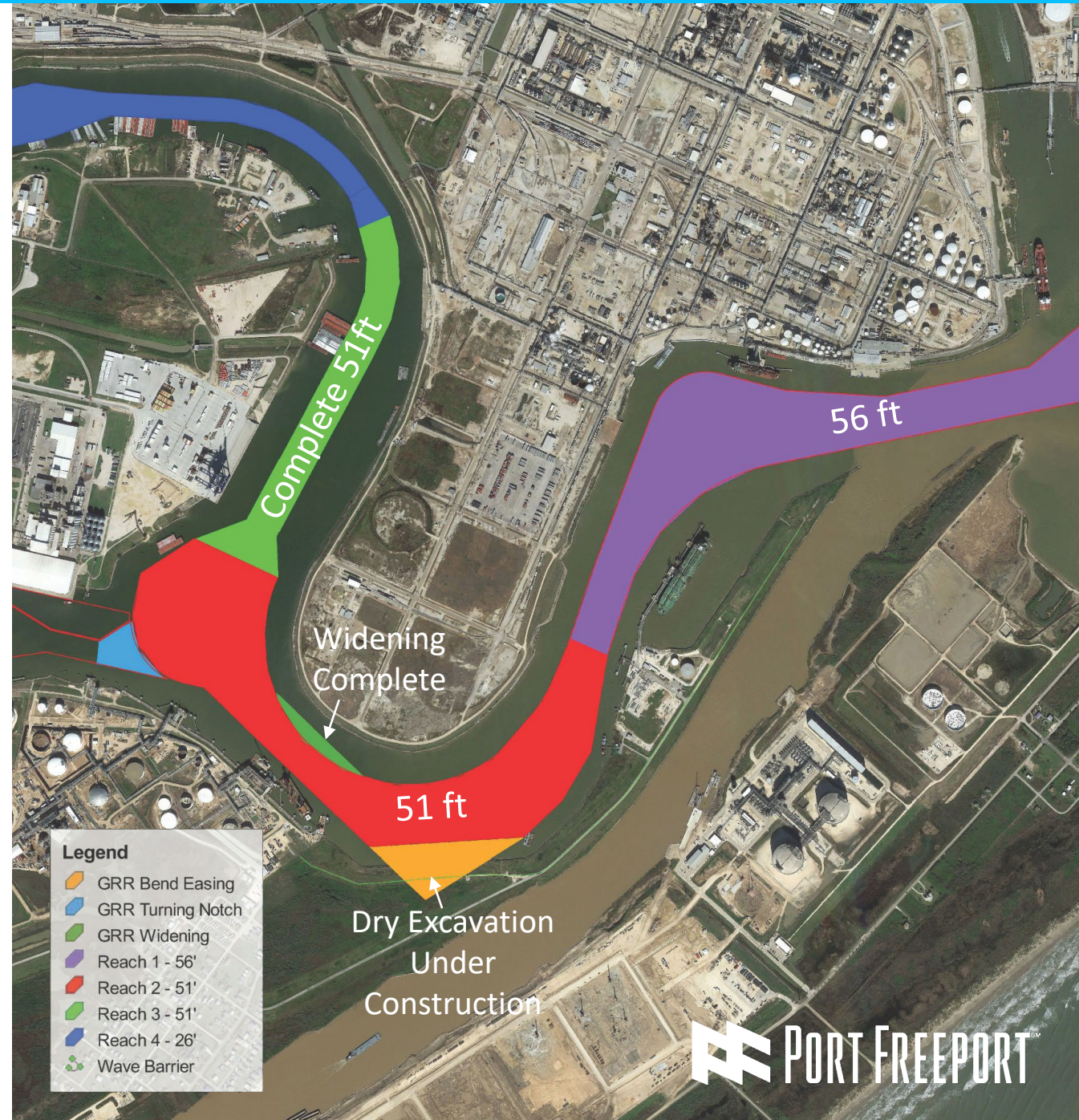

- \$24.9 million federal funding

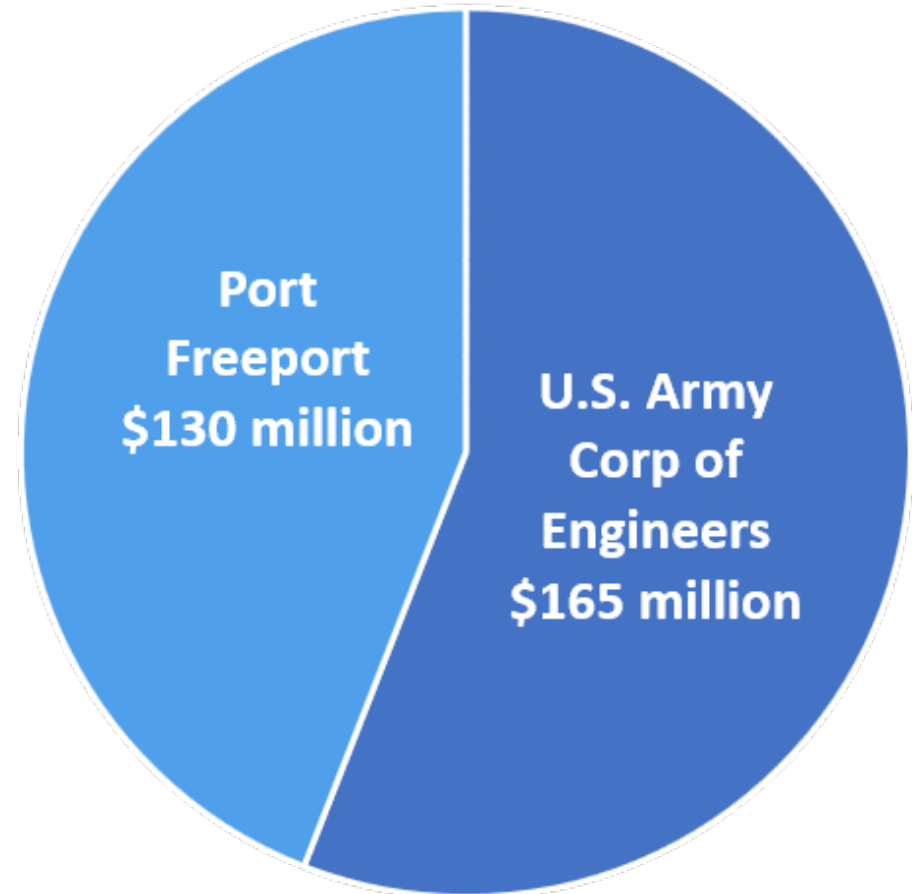

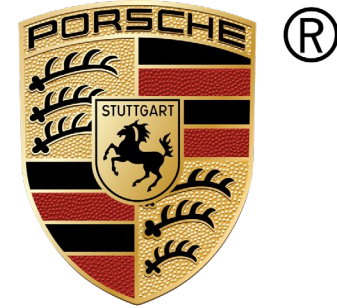
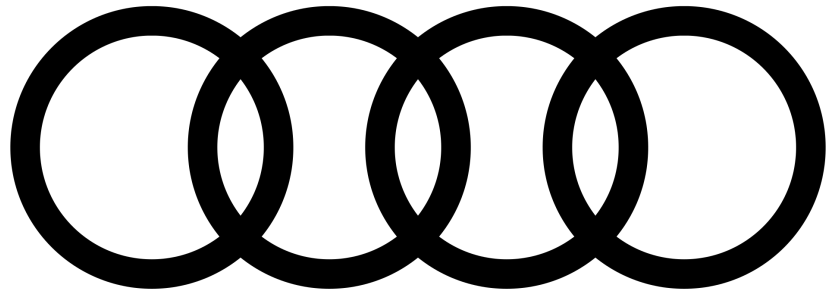

Volkswagen Affiliated Brands to be Imported to the Port



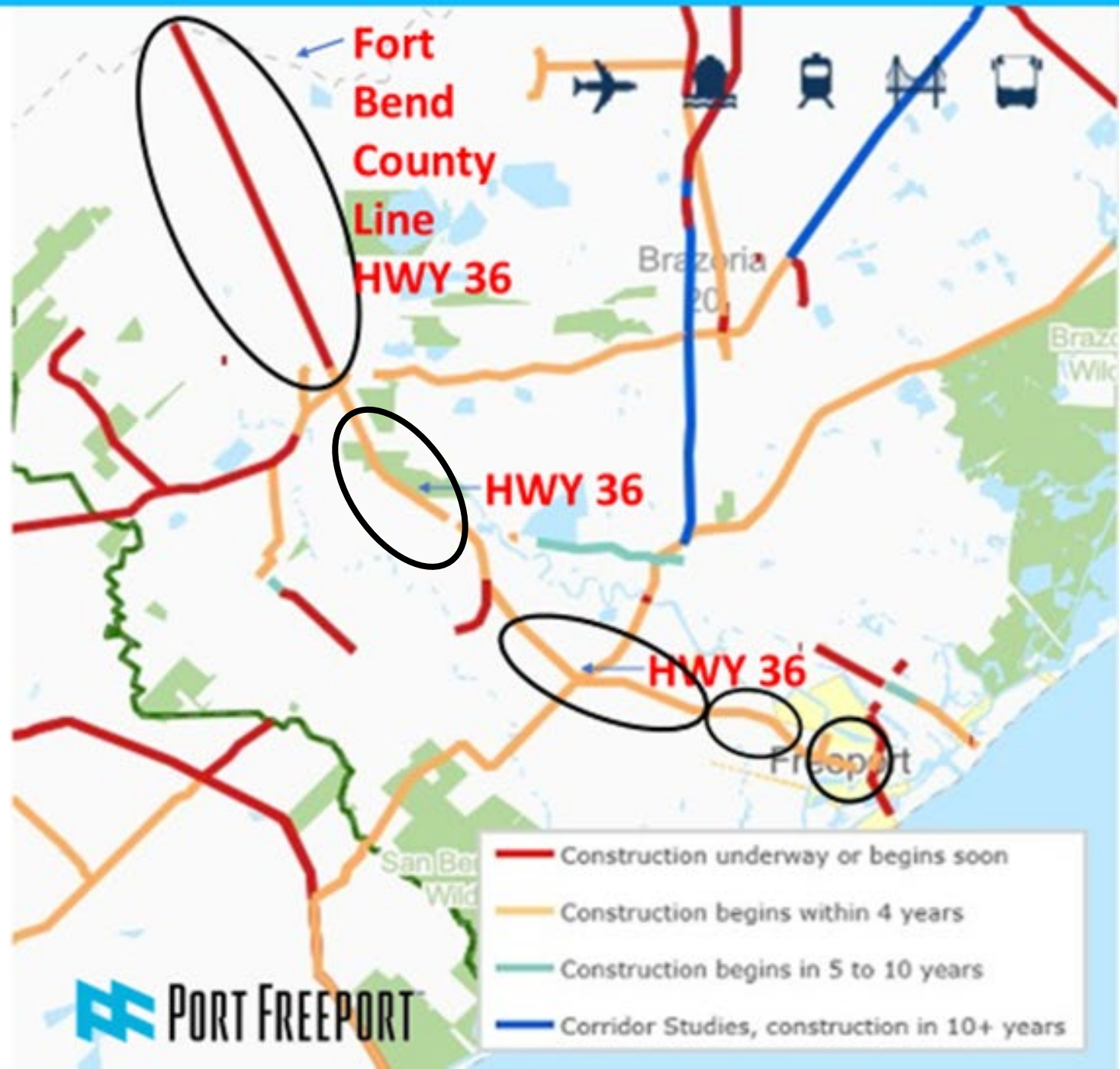
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Port Freeport
