Dear Commissioners:

Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed the traffic control plan for all sections of the Briscoe Falls subdivision. A petition has been submitted with valid signatures representing 27.7 percent of the homes in the subdivision, which meets the required 25 percent threshold, pursuant to Texas Transportation Code Ann. §545.307. The petition is on file in the Engineering Department. Therefore, Engineering recommends the placement of "Overnight Parking of Commercial Vehicles is Prohibited in the Subdivision, 10 pm – 6 am" signs at the locations indicated on the attached traffic control plan. The public hearing date for acceptance for the plan will be scheduled on the next available Commissioner's Court Agenda.

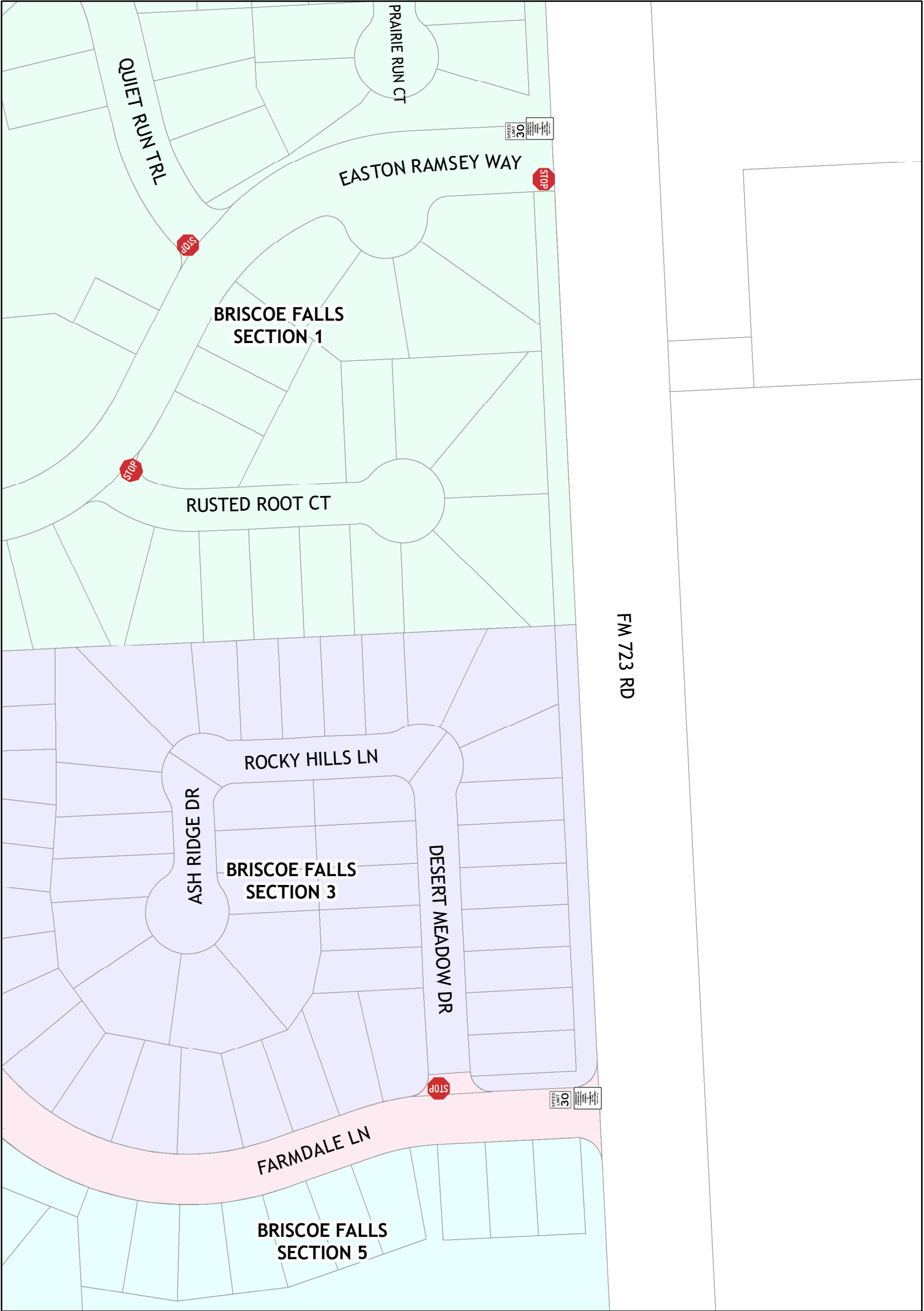

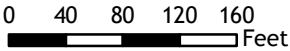
