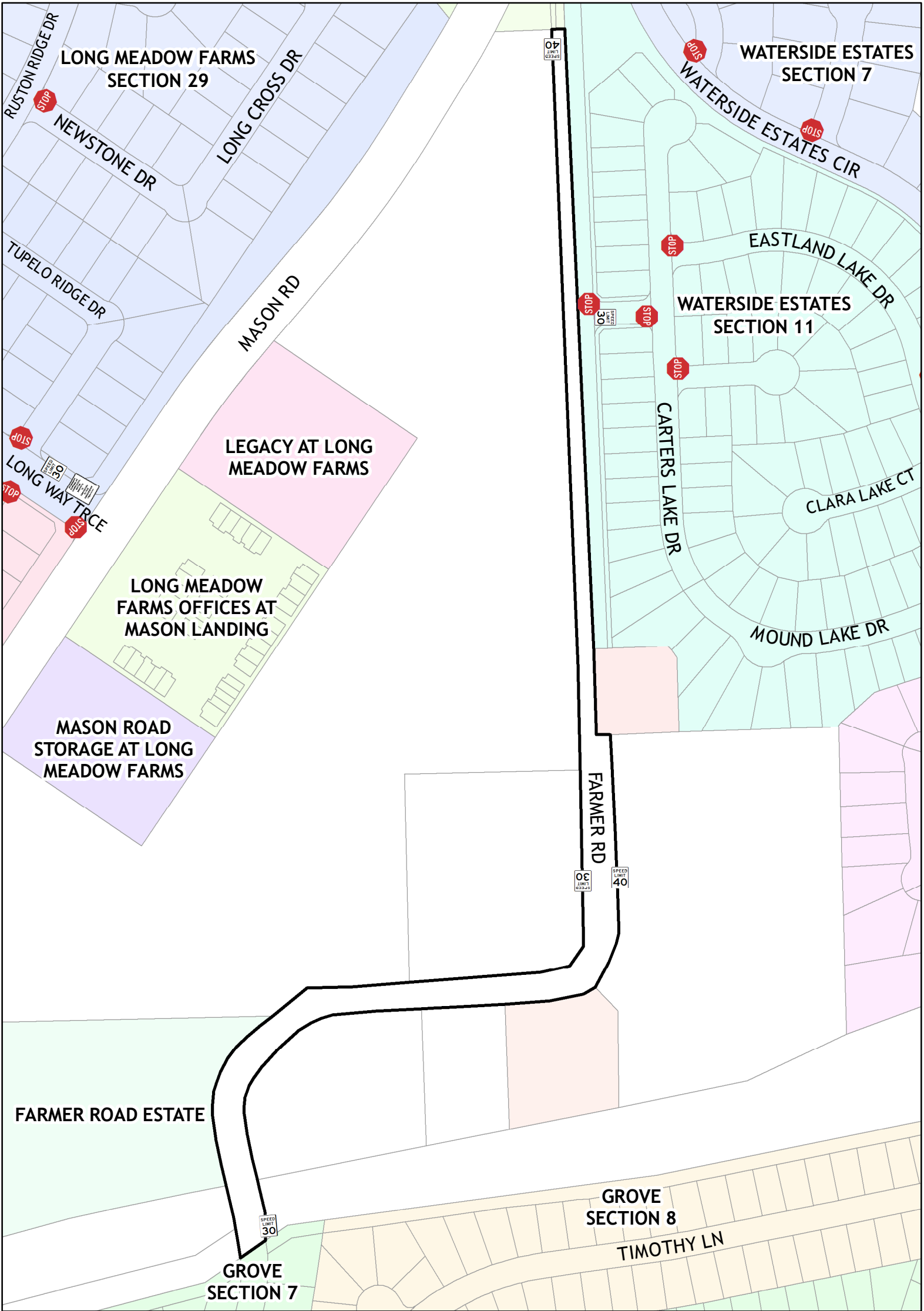
Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed the traffic control plan to establish speed limits on Farmer Road between Oyster Creek and Mason Road. This includes establishing a speed limit of 40 mph for the first 2000 feet south of Mason Road, and a speed limit of 30 mph between that point and Oyster Creek. The road is classified as a Collector in the 2015 Fort Bend County Major Thoroughfare Plan. The public hearing date for acceptance for the plan will be scheduled on the next available Commissioner's Court Agenda.

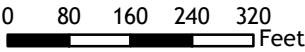
