Addition of "NO PARKING STOPPING STANDING" signs on Breton Falls Lane in Grand Mission Sections 12 & 13 and Daybrook Crossing Lane in Grand Mission Sections 12 & 15

Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed the traffic control plan to prohibit parking, stopping, and standing on both sides of Breton Falls Lane between Grand Mission Boulevard and 100 feet west of Daybrook Crossing Lane, and both sides of Daybrook Crossing Lane between Edge Manor Lane and Mustang Pointe Lane. This prohibition will be in effect on school days between 7:00 and 9:00 a.m. and between 2:00 and 4:00 p.m. The public hearing date for acceptance for the plan will be scheduled on the next available Commissioner's Court Agenda.


