- Approval of this plat will expire one year from City Council approval if not recorded in the Official Public Records of the County of Fort Bend.
   Three—quarter inch (3/4") Iron Rods with caps marked "Quiddity" three feet (3') in length are set on all perimeter boundary corners, all angle points, all points of curvature and tangency, and all block corners, unless otherwise noted.

- Elevations reference the North American Vertical Datum of 1988 (NAVD88) using the Geoid12B Model.

- a. 3/4-inch iron rod with cap stamped Quiddity Engineering located within a pipeline corridor occupied by Energy Transfer, being located South 17"43"32" East, 4544.03 feet from the northern most corner of a called 234.11 acre tract (Tract 2A), both conveyed to Astro Rosenberg, L.P. by Special Warranty Deed recorded under County Clerk's File Number 2021211324, Official Public Records, Fort Bend County, Texas; Said iron rod having Grid Coordinates of
- N = 13,729,541.85 and E = 2,940,372.62 and Elevation = 98.55 feet.
- 16) The top of all floor slabs shall be a minimum of 100.40 feet above mean sea level (NAVD88 datum). In addition, no top of slab elevation shall be less than 24 inches above the lowest top of curb adjacent to the lot in which it lies. In the absence of a curb, the top of slab shall be no less than 24 inches above the highest natural ground along the perimeter of the building foundation and 12 inches above any down gradient roadway or drainage
- 17) Site plans shall be submitted to Fort Bend County and any other applicable jurisdiction for review and approval. Development permits and all other applicable permits shall be obtained from Fort Bend County prior to beginning construction.
- 18) Absent written authorization by the affected utilities, all utility and aerial easements must be kept unobstructed from any non-utility improvements o obstructions by the property owner. Any unauthorized improvements or obstructions may be removed by any public utility at the property owner's expense. While wooden posts and paneled wooden fences along the perimeter and back to back easements and alongside rear lots lines are permitted, they too may be removed by public utilities at the property owner's expense should they be an obstruction. Public utilities may put said wooden posts and paneled wooden fences back up, but generally will not replace with new fencing.

FURTHER, We do hereby certify that we are the owner(s) of all property immediately adjacent to the boundaries of the above and foregoing subdivision of FBC MUD No Remote Water Well where building setback lines or public utility easements are to be established outside the boundaries of the above and foregoing subdivision and do hereby make and establish all building setback lines and dedicate to the use of the public, all public utility easements shown in said adjacent acreage.

FURTHER, We do hereby acknowledge the receipt of the "Orders for Regulation of Outdoor Lighting in the Unincorporated Areas of Fort Bend County, Texas", and do hereby covenant and agree and shall comply with this order as adopted by Fort Bend County Commissioners Court on March 23, 2004, and any subsequent amendments.






