Dear City Council:

This letter shall serve as notice to the governing body of the City of Houston, Texas (“City”) that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County intends to call an election no later than August 13, 2024, to create a County Assistance District pursuant to Chapter 387, Local Government Code, within the City’s extraterritorial jurisdiction in the Fresno area within Fort Bend County, as generally described in Exhibit A attached hereto. The primary purpose of this district is to provide for the construction, maintenance, and improvements of roads, bridges, and drainage facilities. Additional authorized functions of a district include the provision of law enforcement and detention services; the maintenance or improvement of libraries, museums, parks, or other recreational facilities; the provision of services that benefit the public health or welfare, including the provision of firefighting and fire prevention services; or the promotion of economic development and tourism.

This notice is required to be given by Section 387.003(b-1), Texas Local Government Code and must be sent by certified mail, no later than the 60<sup>th</sup> day before the date Commissioners Court calls the election. The Commissioners Court intends to call a November 2024 election.
