Welcome to the 2024 Freedom Tour! The mission is to expose high school students to the Civil Rights movement and to provide them with an adventurous and historical perspective on the significance of these world-changing events. In addition, teens will experience the Civil Rights Movement firsthand and explore what oppression means for their generation and the world.

## **Tour Curriculum**

Teens will participate in challenging, educational, and value-driven growth sessions where they can express themselves regarding their experiences along the tour. They will have opportunities to share their thoughts and process their experiences and feelings on a daily basis. Teens will have time for fun and recreation as well.

#### Meals

Most meals will be provided during the trip (with the exception of meals marked with \$ on the itinerary). Snacks, beverages and water will be provided while on the bus during the entire trip. Teens may also bring healthy snacks and extra money along with them.
