**FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR ON-PREMISE  
VIDEO MANAGEMENT SYSTEM UTILIZING SOURCEWELL  
PROVIDER CONTRACT ID #030421-SCS**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County, (hereinafter “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and Securitas Technology Corporation (hereinafter “Securitas” or “Contractor”), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas, hereinafter referred to collectively as the “Parties.”

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into an agreement for Securitas to provide on-premise video management services on or about November 7, 2023, (the “Agreement”), which is fully incorporated by reference for all purposes. County and Securitas desire to amend said Agreement as set forth below:

I. Amendments

1. **Scope of Work.** Securitas shall provide additional re-programming of IP addresses for 69 cameras as described in Securitas proposal, attached as Exhibit “A” and incorporated fully by reference.
2. **Limit of Appropriation.** The Limit of Appropriation for the performance of these additional services is Three Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Eight and 58/100 Dollars (\$3,748.58). The Limit of Appropriation payable to Securitas under the Agreement is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Seven and 41/100 Dollars (\$148,427.41), authorized as follows:

\$144,678.83 under the Addendum to Performance Contract; and  
\$3,748.58 under this Amendment to Addendum to Performance Contract

In no case shall the amount paid by County for all product and/or services under the Addendum to Performance Contract and this Amendment to Addendum to Performance Contract exceed the above Limit of Appropriation without an agreement executed by the Parties.

3. **Modifications.** Except as modified herein, the Agreement remains in full force and effect and has not been modified or amended.
4. **Conflict.** If there is a conflict among documents, the most recently executed document will prevail with regard to the conflict.

5. **Understanding, Fair Construction.** By execution of this Amendment, the Parties acknowledge that they have read and understood each provision, term and obligation contained in this Amendment. This Amendment, although drawn by one party, shall be construed fairly and reasonably and not more strictly against the drafting party than the nondrafting party.
  
6. **Severability.** If any provision of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions remain in full force, if the essential terms and conditions of this Agreement for each party remain valid, binding, and enforceable.

**Reason for Labor Change Order**

New cameras come with installed IP addresses from the factory that allow the NVR and software to automatically recognize the cameras and establish a video connection.

It was discussed, however, in the initial Kick Off meeting to begin the project, that the County IT Dept. preferred to provide Securitas with a custom range of IP addresses for the cameras.

Since the IP addresses that came with the cameras were not compatible with the County IT Dept's IP Addressing scheme, the cameras would not make the connection to the NVR.

The new IP addresses have to be manually programmed by computer at each network switch location for each camera.

This need for additional technician labor hours was not known at the time the pricing and scope of work proposal was created.

**Securitas Scope of Work**

Securitas will program the County provided IP addresses for 59 existing cameras at the Bamore facility, 5 cameras at the Fairgrounds Park N Ride, 2 cameras at the U of H Park N Ride and 3 cameras at the AMC Park N Ride.

**Fort Bend County to Provide**

Access to IT rooms and network switches as needed by the Securitas technician.
